Joint Committee's Proposals.

INVESTIGATION BASED ON INTERESTS OF NATIVES AND NON-NATIVES.

The Government of Kenya announced on Friday of last week the appointment of a "Financial Commission" to visit Kenya and report on matters of taxation, railway rates and import duties and public expenditure so far as they affect natives and non-natives.

The official statement reads—

The Secretary of State for the Colonies intimates that he has invited Lord Moyne (formerly Lt.-Col. the Rt. Hon. Walter Guinness, P.C., T.D.S.), as our first Financial Secretary to the Treasury, and Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, to proceed to Kenya as Financial Commissioner, with the following terms of reference—

- (1) To enquire into the matters specified in paragraph 18(1) of the Report of the Joint Select Committee on Closer Union in East Africa, viz—
 - (a) the contribution made to taxation, both direct and indirect, by the different racial communities;
 - (b) railway freight and transport duties, with a view to discovering the extent which such community benefits or suffers by them;
 - (c) the amount of money expended in the interests of each community, in particular on natives and non-natives; and
 - (d) the degree and manner in which financial responsibility should be conferred on the native councils.
- (2) So far as may be necessary for the purposes of the above Enquiry to consider the general financial and economic situation of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya, and
- (3) to make a Report.

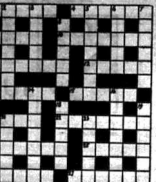

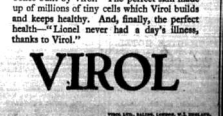

Dr. Uvarov's Advice.

REPEITIONS ALMOST INEVITABLE DURING NEXT DECADE.

Dr. Uvarov of the Imperial Institute of Entomology who is probably the most authoritative locust expert in the world declares there is scarcely any doubt that the present locust infestation in East Africa will continue for at least one or two years and possibly much longer.

He is of the opinion that the repetition of the terrible experiences of the last few years will once occur or recur within the next ten or fifteen years with even greater economic consequences.

Reports of laying in Uganda and Tanganyika with heavy infestation in the Mandated Territory are contained in the weekly statement in Nairobi yesterday.

Mere Laying Reported.

An expert opinion on the position in East Africa has been given for the use of the Joint East African Board in its recent meeting. It is provisionally agreed by the Colonial Office by Dr. Uvarov, expert on the locust, that the present infestation is a mere laying and not a full-blown invasion.

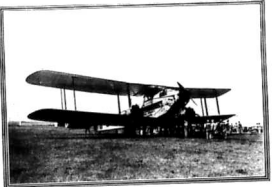

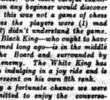

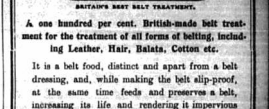
