# Sensation in the Irish Free State.

## PROTEST BY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL

### Alleged Discourtesy.

#### STRONG LETTERS TO PRESIDENT OF THE EXECUTIVE.

A sensation has been caused in the Irish Free State by the release of correspondence between the Governor-General and Mr. De Valera, in which the former alleges that he has been discourteously treated.

The Governor-General, Mr. James McNeill, has threatened to resign unless Mr. De Valera and his Cabinet apologise.

While Mr. McNeill released the correspondence, Mr. De Valera informed the Irish newspapers by telephone that under the Official Secrets Act publication was prohibited. This prohibition, however, was subsequently withdrawn.

### Resignation Threat.

Dublin, July 11. There is a first also occasion in the history of the Irish Free State when the Governor-General Mr. James McNeill and Mr. de Valera are said to have had a serious falling out.

The crisis of the letters is that Mr. McNeill threatened to resign unless Mr. De Valera and his Cabinet apologise, but, as it is reported, they have not yet done so.

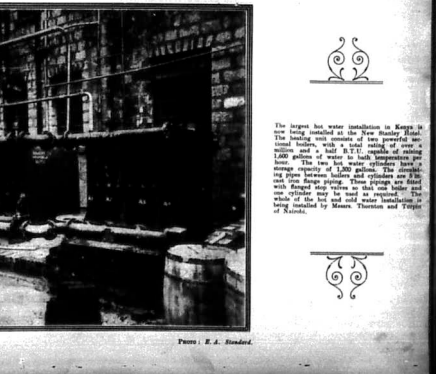

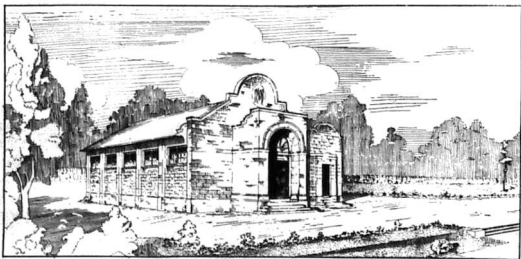

## TO ACT AS ADVISORY BOARD.

Some considerable time ago may be recalled, a circular letter was addressed to the various cricket clubs in the country round the question of the Kenya Football Club acting as the governing body of the game in the Colony. Prior to that latter group of letters there was no governing body, and it was beyond the power of the various cricket unions just prior to this time to have any say in the matter. It was through the suggestion for a Cricket Association that a ruling body was at last formed to deal with any future cricketing matters.

It will be remembered that the suggestion that the question of an Association to act as a governing body of the game was made in the fact that the Kenya Football Club was formed but there seemed to grow up a divergence of opinion with regard to the point of instituting something in the way of a governing body.

At the result of that circular letter issued by the Kenya Football Club, replies have been received in which the suggestion that the Kenya Association should be formed has been strongly supported. These letters were sent out to members of the various clubs and football clubs, and replies were received in all instances save in the former instance, and all but two in the latter. Each and every reply lent strength to the original suggestion, and today the Kenya Association has come to be recognized as the ruling body for the game in Kenya.

Without a doubt the game is a wise one. Cricket has been a sport without a doubt for the past but now that something in the way of an M.C.C. has been organized, the game should go further afield. The Kenya Club will act in the nature of an Advisory Board for the game in those parts. It will be their function to conduct the management of visits of touring teams, to arrange representative matches, and to appoint captains for each game, who will be personally responsible for the selection of their respective teams.

In regard to the forthcoming Official versus Gentlemen' game in October, for which arrangements have already been made, it is not the intention of the Kenya to control conditions or impose cricket, which will remain in the hands of the committee at present responsible.
