AIRMEN VERY BUSY.

EYE-WITNESS REPORT.

From headquarters a descriptive report on operations based this afternoon says that Wednesday the third, a perfect day for heavy cannonade near Perilly (only 17 miles from Paris). SIX SHIPS CAPTURED OR SUNK.

London, Tuesday. The Secretary to the Admiralty announced that six German merchant ships in the past few days captured and sunk in the Indian Ocean the steamers "Tunero," "Eing Lee," "Rita," "Eglo," and "Cryofield," and captured the collier "Bura." The crews were transferred to the "Cryofield," which was also captured but released and ordered to take the crews to Colombo.

MOVEMENT OF FLEET.

Petrograd, Wednesday. Thirty-eight German warships, including five battleships and seven transport appeared off Windau (Baltic Province), on Sept. 29. They subsequently set anchor southwards.

London, Wednesday. A Budapest telegram mentions a battle on Sept. 28, at Malonasz in Hungary. AIR PILOTS IN GERMAN TERRITORY.

SOME INTERESTING PARTICULARS.

A young aviator, who is hurrying back to Africa to join his corps, in a recent interview, was good enough to communicate to a representative of the "Standard" some particulars which came under his notice while a fellow-passenger on board ship with the German South-West Africa in April last. He said: There is a reason to believe that I am a professional aviator, who is a professional aviator, and who approached the Durban Municipal Council in the German Government to carry out a series of experiments on the behavior of air balloons, as well as to compare the machine he was interested in with others of his kind.

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN OUR AIRPLANES (ENGLISH AND FRENCH) AND THE GERMAN'S.

The letter is based on much stronger facts than is larger reported. It is not this but to be purchased at the cost of good service on being used in the air. Replying to another question, he said: "Night is the time to fly in these latitudes, but only for the reason that our machines are not so fast that they might be seen by the southern African coast, and it is possible to discern the outline of the country, particularly so in the case of the mountains, where land and sea unite. You can always distinctly make out the coast line, and the machine might be seen between land and water being unmistakable. Asked for his opinion about the present aeroplane crew, all our informant could say was that they were enemy machines, and that there were three or four detached about the country from which petrol supplies were drawn.

DISRAELI ON PRUSSIA.

FORECAST OF MARITIME DEVELOPMENT.

Two passages from Disraeli's speech in Parliament in 1861—a couple of generations ago—have a remarkable appropriateness at the present moment. They were good enough to forecast in a general way the course and foresight in a high degree; might into the essential character of Prussian policy, and might as to German maritime development. In the first speech, on February 15, says a correspondent to the Times, he was discussing Cobden's claim that free trade would give us the beams of perpetual peace. This Disraeli said, was no new idea. At Utrecht the Abbe St. Pierre proposed that the nations should agree to perpetual peace; but he was prepared to use force to compel them. In fact, his system "assumed war as a permanent element of perpetual peace, looking only at the material interests of such nations as America, France, and England. But war was contemplated and satisfied, but by the race or the price who agitate for a position."

It is a remarkable case. At this moment Liberal gentlemen refer to it with great delight; and certainly, setting our own imperial jangles, there is probably no nation in Europe, whether we look to general civilization, diffused knowledge, public intelligence, or in the arms of the sea, that can place a superior to Prussia. But only a few years before St. Pierre laid down his principle, Prussia did not exist. But Margaret of Brandenburg, consort of great talents and a devoted wife, was the first to lay down the universal peace from existing circumstances, but to be maintained if circumstances should be so altered as to be essentially superior.

The second speech, on April 10, deals with the dispute between us and Denmark over Schleswig-Holstein; and shows that Disraeli, before his countrymen in general, was the real measure of what was passing before his eyes, realized the fully important fact that Germany had embarked on a policy which would eventually make her a great maritime Power, the rival of England in the North Sea. These were his words:

Germany is the centre of Europe and has no reason, one would think, to complain of the territorial advantages which have been allotted to it. Its broad and rich lands are watered by the Rhine, the Danube, the Elbe, and the Danube. But Germany, which possesses almost every other advantage, is not a great naval Power, and Germany wants a fleet. This is the real reason why Denmark, supposed to be weak, is to be invaded in this age of liberty on the plea of nationality. It is to gain the harbor of the Baltic and to secure the mouths of the Elbe that the plea of German nationality is put forth. Hitlers in the Baltic, Russia and the Scandinavian peninsula have prevented this project of Germany, which Holland and Great Britain have intercepted in the North Sea. It is a national development. But now, under shelter of the plea of nationality, taking advantage of the fact that the King of Denmark possesses in Schleswig, perhaps 150,000 soldiers of German race, he dominates as to be invaded and may be compared, notwithstanding the valor of his few but determined subjects, in order that Prussia may suddenly appear as a great maritime Power. I do not wish to argue this case with you to the interests of England. I do not wish to say anything about whether it is or is not for the interest of England that a new naval Power should spring up among the nations of the Baltic, or the Northern Sea. But this I wish to lay down as a principle—like it for the interest of England, and like it for the interest of all Europe, that peace should be maintained, and that the German fleet should be permitted to pass unobstructed and uncontrolled.

The dismantling of Denmark was prevented in 1864; but it was effected in 1864, and was immediately followed by the defeat of Austria in 1866 and the crushing of France in 1870. The rapid growth of the German mercantile marine and the passing of the famous Navy Laws have followed in the same course. Sixty-six years ago, when the early dangers apprehended came from Russia and France, Disraeli appreciated the true spirit of Prussian policy and foresaw, at least in a measure, the development from which the world is now suffering.

AIRMEN'S BOLD FEAT. ZEPPELIN WRECKED. 200 GUNS BEFORE ANTWERP.

Antwerp, Friday. The bombardment of Antwerp continued on Friday with full force. It had slackened somewhat in the early morning of Saturday. The sky throughout the night was a red flame. Half a million fugitives have arrived in Holland and more trains are expected.

London, Friday. The Germans are before Antwerp with two hundred guns of twenty-eight, thirty and forty-two calibres, and a range of fortifications. There was a full moon ten o'clock to midnight last night, when the bombardment was resumed most violently.

London, Friday. Through the Press Bureau, the Admiralty announces that Commander Spencer Grey, an author, carried out with Lieutenant Murray and Skipper a successful attack on the Zeppelin. The Zeppelin was destroyed from a height of five hundred feet. He put the Zeppelin and destroyed a Zeppelin. The Germans were obliged to send five hundred feet high above the sea, but their own planes were lost. The British aircraft made a distance of over a hundred miles as witnessed by the German press which lied on the evening on anti-aircraft guns.

London, Friday. The Press Bureau gives the story of a Zeppelin with the British head-quarters who describe the operations from Wednesday, Sept. 29. The Zeppelin was in a gradual descent from the straits, and a slight attack was made by the enemy. There was a perfect Autumn day, and every-where during the night the Zeppelins made a few new trenches. The air was misty, and the mist grew thicker at night. The artillery annihilated a Zeppelin which the enemy occupied as an advance post, their guns and quick-fires, long shelled. The Germans made their usual two night attacks on the outposts and we lay out an wounded and captured the enemy's trenches which we filled in.

London, Friday. A communique states that the general situation is unchanged. The two cavalry brigades continue to operate north of Leffe-Arras-Hazy-Clunies-Brye-Launoy. There has been only slight fighting from the line to the Meuse. At Wever, an artillery duel is proceeding along the whole front. There is no change in German, Belgian and French.

London, Friday. The London Metal Exchange has resolved that all naturalised British candidates for membership must give proof of exemption from citizenship of the country of their origin, also that from the new year submitted and unannounced checks must be British subjects.

London, Friday. The Mon-origins have reached the fortieth mile outside Sarajevo (Bosnia).

London, Friday. A German communique states that there are no signs of any appearance to result from the wireless theatre. The Russians are marching from Letzka and have reached Lysk. The attack on the Antwerp inner forts has started.

The communique admits that a bomb from a hostile aeroplane, yesterday, pierced the roof of a Zeppelin in the Düsseldorf girth hall.

London, Friday. We are pleased to learn that Capt. Leitch, who was wounded in the right shoulder, at Caen, is progressing favourably.
