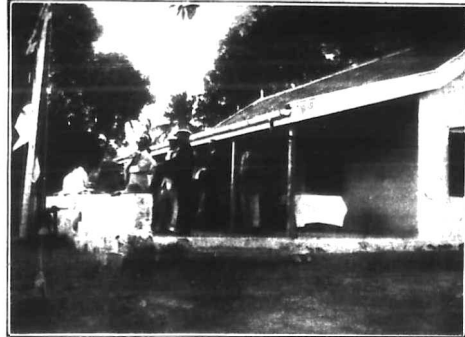

work by natives and strive after the ideal of a perfectly balanced, and therefore, a perfectly efficient, composite whole.

We would urge caution in the selection of the recruits. We would point to the example of South Africa, the case of which country is analogous to ours, and where the premier corps are mainly composed of Public School Boys.

We would impress upon the Government the immediate necessity of forming a nucleus upon which to build a police corps on the lines we suggested. To our minds, crime in the country is steadily on the increase and as the native becomes more and more familiar with civilization so is only wiser to suggest that all endeavours should be made by the Government to keep step with the most urgent need of the country.

Your Committee beg to supplement these remarks by calling attention to certain grievances which have been brought to their notice.

While natives can hold no common standard it is a considerable derogatory to European to rank them as mendicants. It is thought that the system gives rise to considerable dissatisfaction amongst the Europeans, while the native non-com. is given absurd ideas as to his status. Your Committee think that the matter could be very easily remedied, either by grading the native or by grading the European.

A very material grievance exists in the absence of given such allowance as is necessary to provide themselves with food when cases of mendicancy attend when men are absent overnight from their stations.

We find that a D.S.P. gets Rs. 5 per day, an A.D.S.P. Rs. 4 per day and an Inspector Rs. 2.50 per day, while a E.P.C. and a native gets nothing.

It is surely not considered by the powers that be that the lower in rank one is, the less he eats, until, when lowest rank is reached the appetite is zero. We consider that the system is most unfair and requires immediate attention, and think that the minimum subsistence allowance for Europeans should be Rs. 2.50 per day.

The Committee recommend that natives should be given such allowance as is necessary to provide themselves with food when absent on duty from their stations. This would give them an incentive for obtaining food by lawful means and also relieve their European superiors from the hardship of having to supply them with posho out of their own pockets as is often done by zealous officers now.

With regard to the grievance that now exist as regards a policeman's want of prospects the Committee consider that with a proper expansion of the Police and Administration, in keeping with the progress of the country, there should be little ground for complaint in that line in the future.

Mr Arnold spoke with some warmth regarding to the date of the Convention meetings. Some argued that it should fall in with the rains. He did not agree. They come here for business, not for pleasure, and must show sufficient public spirit to give up their time to the business in hand, quite apart from pleasure.

It was agreed that the next meeting be held on the last Monday in January next, irrespective of the date of the rains.

Mr Watkins moved a hearty vote of thanks to the President for the tactful way in which he had conducted the proceedings, and he congratulated him upon the position he had taken up. The vote was carried with applause.

A vote of thanks was passed to the East African Standard for their courtesy in

furnishing the delegates with copies of the Secretary of State's replies to the Labour Report.

In conclusion, the Chairman referred to the serious step which was shortly to be taken by their Secretary, Mr. S. Donnelly. They had subscribed to make him a presentation, and on being consulted he had asked that the form of this should be decided by the lady who he was about to marry. They would both have the good wishes of the Convention and he (the Chairman) did not think anyone had ever more fully earned the acknowledgment they were making. Mr. Donnelly suitably replied. He would never prize any acknowledgment more than the vote of confidence accorded him eighteen months ago by the Convention. The proceedings terminated after 11 o'clock on Wednesday night.

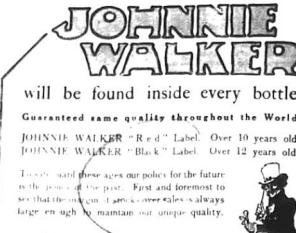

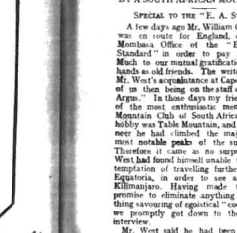

(Continued from page 4) of all parties, to discuss a compromise. Lord Curzon thought the drawing of the line under the Bill would be unworkable and end in a deadlock. Whatever the Government in power, there would have to be a conference. Lord Crew, referring to the proposed conference now or later, with a view to a permanent settlement, said if the scrapping of their policy was to be a preliminary to it, it would be impossible to attain their aim. However, as we have seen from dismissing the idea that the best plan for permanent settlement was a conference between Lord Curzon and Sir Edward Carson, Mr. Balfour and Mr. O'Brien. Meanwhile, all they could do at present was to strive to meet the situation which had given rise to the Bill.
