March 6.—The Transvaal Ministry was sworn in on the 4th instant.

March 5.—The Right Honble Sir Henry Mann Collins has been appointed a Lord of Appeal in succession to Lord Davey, Sir Herbert Hardy Cozens-Hardy has been appointed Master of the Rolls.

March 5.—Mr Justice Kennedy has been appointed to succeed Sir H. H. Cozens-Hardy.

## Our Navy.

Mar. 1.—The Naval Estimates show a reduction of £ 1,437,000 and a thousand new constructions will cost £ 8,100,000 compared with £ 9,253,000 in 1906/07 and instead, unless the Naval Powers come to some understanding at the League Conference, two Dreadnaughts one fast unarmoured Cruiser, 5 Gunboats and 13 Torpedo Destroyers, 12 Torpedo Boats and 17 Submarines.

Mar. 2.—Lord Trenchard speaking at Weymouth said that the present Government intended to continue the policy of their predecessors as far as the Navy is concerned and that there was no fear of their doing anything to weaken its strength.

### EAST AFRICA WELLS TREATED.

March 7.—The Civil Service Estimates include grants in aid for Wei Wei £10,000 an increase of £5,500, East Africa £102,970 a decrease of £11,025 and Uganda £90,000 a decrease of £27,000.

### PROGRESSIVES HOPELESSLY DEFEAT.

Mar. 2.—To-day's elections to the London County Council are resulting almost as much in favour of the Progressives as Parliament Elections.

March 4.—The result of the County Council elections is a sweeping defeat to the Progressives. 79 Moderates or self styled Municipal Reformers were elected and 59 Progressives Compared with 35 Moderates and 53 Progressives in 1904.

### KIEL'S SAFETY.

March 7.—The Times Correspondent in Paris draws attention to Germany's present pre-eminant position in Denmark and criticises the Baltic's "mare clausum" by the neutralisation of the Straits thereby securing the safety of Kiel.

Comments on the German Elections.

Our Berlin correspondent writes: The decisive elections on the second ballot from the 1st to the 5th of February, have completed what the principal elections on the first ballot had begun to do, and have established the Socialists. On the first ballot the party lost 19 seats and on the second ballot they suffered a further loss of 17, so that their net loss amounts to 36 seats; that is more than 2.5 of their previous strength. The importance of the Socialists was greatest in Central and North Germany. Along the sea coast, they previously held 10 constituencies, but this number is now reduced to 1. In Saxony, which sends 42 representatives to the Reichstag, 27 Socialists returned at the previous election numbered 22, and in their overwhelming majority spoke of Saxony as the Red Kingdom, in the present election they have lost 11 of these seats, so that the red colour now covers only 1/3 of this Kingdom. Their defeat was comparatively still greater in the small States of Thuringia. There the Socialists, who at the present election had 14 members, but at the present election they have lost every seat.

The defeat of the Socialists would have been still more emphatic, if in the eyes of the irascible hatred against the existing state of society, which the German Socialists express more recklessly than those in any other country, it is an act of self-denial of the part of every party representing the middle classes when it comes to their help. The system in vogue up to the present has been to incur money for persons to pay an annual sum to lawyers, this sum to cover all the expenses of the year except of course Court fees and a certain amount for litigation and only has to face the Court fees which in many instances are quite high.

If a writ is taken the costs to himself as a sort of profit transaction which is contrary to the spirit of legal procedure and apt to make a pleader's rate into Court with a view of supplementing that portion of his income derived from A.
