stage the Native is ripe for good Government but when that good Government is not administered to him he begins to think himself an equal and attempts to step into a position above his rightful place.

When Natives reach the stage of insolence the cause is always the local Government. It is the fault of indifference, ignorance, mistaken justice, or willfulness on the part of those under whose control they have been who have failed to count such acts as unjust and natives have been guilty of in Nairobi, mainly, quarrelling behaviour to white women.

As time went on Natanah's men-hood broke down to them and they rose to stifle this fearful cry. But they have found that it takes a longer time to stamp out an existing evil than it does to prevent it from coming into existence.

With these experiences before us we must see to it and at once that the curial evil gets no foothold with a stern hand. It is pitiful to hear the hopeless arguments that the white man is the same as the black man.

It cannot be that it has been proved false without number that it is a fallacy an impossible policy, cruel to the native and unjust to the white man. Are not our natives forbidden to prospect for minerals on their own lands?

It is necessary, for us to even suggest that our law for both is the same. Let us then face the problem before us. Let us be aware of the "fasting policy" of the past, through the ignorant impetuosity of their masters, that civilian white men are fiercer than the white men of the "Straits" in their spirit and a lower order of men, which is not bearing and will yet bear better fruit.

Our laws do not make a distinction for the death penalty to be inflicted on a native guilty of abominable conduct. Therefore these laws must be amended otherwise we do not see how we can prevent the introduction of "Mob Law," a law hateful in itself, but one which has always forced itself into our eyes where black and white live side by side, when stern necessity arises for vengeance.
