The war and Mr. Hilare Belter, speaking to the Manchester Geographical Society, is the largest business upon which any nation has ever been engaged. There is so far, not the least sign that this result can be achieved, but in spite of these desperate conflicts going on between the Veritas and the Warta, the Russians have sustained there no serious defeat.
