PRUSSIAN WAR ON EUROPE.

Fourth Time and the Last.

SPEECH BY SIR E. GREY.

(SIR EDWARD GREY'S ADDRESS.)

London, Mar. 22. Sir Edward Grey, speaking on the origin of the war, emphasized that all might have been avoided by a European conference. Germany judging from her experience in the Italian conference, knew she could not win, but she refused every suggestion. On her part, for all time, the appalling responsibility for the war. Sir Edward Grey affirmed, said loud cheers, that this was the fourth time, when living memory, that Prussia had made war upon Europe. We were determined that it should be the last.

Sir Edward Grey added that it would have been far easier to settle the dispute between Austria and Serbia, which she many made the occasion of war, than it was successfully to get through the Balkan crisis. Germany, he said, would not do diplomatic triumph. We did not give ourselves to an intrigue. We pursued, impartially and honestly, the course of peace. We were ready last July to do the same, but Germany, by her attitude, refused to agree upon her word to receive any further attacks. We had to stand from her but one thing, namely, an unconditional promise to stand aside, however aggressive Prussia, having made us to her tough, bours.

France, Italy and Russia were ready, in July, to accept the British proposals, but that, after the British proposals for a conference had been made it was proposed to force the issue. It was not until the conference had failed that the Allies were forced to the Hague. We now know that only one power which had planned could be proposed.

The British Empire continued, long before the war he had given Belgium a pledge that never would we violate her neutrality as long as it is respected by others. If Germany invaded Belgium we were bound to oppose Germany with all our strength. If we had done this at the first moment, was there anyone now who believed that when German attacks on the Belgians, that non-combatants, ravaged the country and trampled all the rules of war, and all the rules of humanity, were there anyone who thought it possible now that we could still have looked on, without eternal disgrace?

The one essential condition in the terms of peace must be the restoration to Belgium of her independence and national life, the possession of her territory and resources, as far as possible, for the cruel wrong done to her. The great cause for which the Allies were fighting was that which the world has seen in the past.
