THE RUSSIAN RETIREMENT. PEACE PROPOSALS WILL FOLLOW THE FAILURE OF THE GERMAN OFFENSIVE IN POLAND.

BY OUR SPECIAL CORRESPONDENT EDGAR WALLACE.

What is the meaning of the rapid German advance in East Prussia and what does the steady Russian retirement, not only in that district but also in the West... There are the questions which are on all lips at the present moment and they are questions which will be asked as long as the Russian retreat continues.

It is hardly understood that Russia has now reached the first stage of her own panic. Without all this talk of having been assembled she has even considerable losses concentrated on the line, long and short, and the real test of strength has now come. The advance into East Prussia was never intended to succeed, certainly the Russians in that region. It is an error to say that the forces opposed to the Russian north of the line of the 50th parallel.

It is not possible to concentrate forces north of the line of the 50th parallel, as the line is pressed by the Germans. The advance in that direction is a tactical mistake, for the Russian command is not in a position to make a railway communication to the north, and the Russian command is not in a position to make a railway communication to the north.
