H. G. WELLS AND SCIENTIFIC METHOD.

Mr. H. G. Wells writes a very interesting letter to the "Times," in which he speaks for a scientific method in the conduct of the war.

"We have," he says, "reconstructed our Government, and it is not clear that our Englishmen understand the advantages and disadvantages of the re-arrangement of the House of Commons."

"But there is a matter behind the range of party politics which should be more closely attended, and which has been almost completely disregarded in all the discussions that lead to the Coalition, and that is the very small part we are still giving the scientific man, and the small respect we are showing scientific method in the conduct of this war."

"I submit that there is urgent need for bringing imaginative enterprise and our scientific resources of scientific knowledge to the assistance of the modern energies of the Coalition, that this is not being done, and that until it is done this war is being fought on a level and in a manner which is not only to drag us and to infinitely more costly and infinitely less conclusive than it could and should be."

"Lorenz war is essentially a struggle of guess and invention. It is not war under permanent conditions. In that respect it differs completely from the permanent wars. Each side must be perpetually producing new devices, surprise and surprise the opponent."

"Since this has been the German method of fighting has been changed again and again. They have produced novelty after novelty, and each novelty has been saved from their hands and unexpectedly destroyed."

"Our Danubian exploit has been throughout inferior to the German, and we have produced no counterstroke to the enemy's submarine, and no efficient project against his battery torpedo-boats."

"One instance of many will serve to show what I am driving at. In the early part of the war we were being pulled up by industry returns by the millions and making strong new efforts to equip them with rifles. At the meantime, the actual experience of the war has been fully met with the production of national quality which still make them for attacks, and they are entering their

very small and light machine-guns in many cases to effect."

"They have, in fact, adopted as their chief model of trench defence the proper scientific thing. Against this we fire our shrapnel and our artillery."

"Now these machine-guns are not innumerable failures. But they are likely to go on until we create some supplementary line of fire, some other line in which the creative forces of our national life, and particularly our scientific and our engineering scientific soldiers and sailors, have a full representation and a strong voice."

"It is not the sort of work for which a great light and rapid career fits a man. That training and experience, valuable as it is in the management of a great machine, does indeed very largely unfit men for this (invaluable) inventive work."

"A great part of our present special aptitude for making modern war that has been diagnosing diseases or planning a great scientific expedition. It is a seasonal business. We want an arming sub-committee of scientific and technically competent men for the highly specialized task."

GRECE. The announcement that
the King of Greece has decided to
form a new cabinet indicates not only
a somewhat tardy recognition of popular
sentiment; it also points to the break-down
of what, in the absence of a better word,
may be called a Germanophile reaction.
The same forces that failed so ignominiously
in the Balkans, are now being turned
loose in Athens. In the endeavor to exclude
Venizelos from power, German "diplomats"
have resorted to the most unscrupulous
method of the gutter. Amongst other
attempts, they have suggested that the
real object of M. Venizelos, more than
the royal house, and establish a republic.
The suggestion, which is entirely in
accordance with the combination of un-
scrupulous and unscrupulous, has
characteristics all German intrigue. Greek
politicians know, even better than the rest
of the world, that M. Venizelos, more than
any other minister, is responsible for the
stability of the royal authority in Greece
today. But it is always the same when
the heavy, blundering intelligence of Ger-
man statesmen is directed to a certain
leader in the field of high politics. The
situation at which it is now arrived, can
not, doubt, has been established by the
defeat of the German public mind. It has
fallen in Greece, as it has fallen in
Germany, in view of the fact that the
chief German propagandist in Athens,
Bismarck, has been so completely
discredited.
