conspire with the German colonial forces station. The nature of the apparatus installed almost invariably secured the safety of the German batteries. In Germany the preparations made were very extensive. In addition to the wireless stations of the Navy and higher power stations were erected. Further, a large thirty-four station wireless plant was installed in strategic positions on the frontiers. The special functions of these stations were to connect with the German stations, so that, by means of their direction and the known bearings of the latter stations, such craft could, by a simple graphical calculation, make for any given point with certainty.

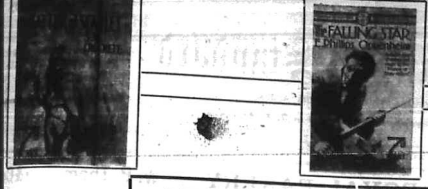
