 THE SAN FRANCISCO DISASTER.

ISSUE OF BONDS.

April 27. There was an earthquake, shaking with intensity on Tuesday at San Francisco which shook the walls of the ruined buildings still standing. It was felt also at Oakland and Hayward.
 April 27. The Governor of California is giving a special Session of the Legislature to authorize the issue of bonds for the reconstruction of San Francisco.

WOMEN'S FRANCHISE.

April 27. An unprecedented scene occurred in the House of Commons yesterday when Mr. Keir Hardie moved a resolution in favour of women's franchise, the ladies in the gallery constantly interrupting the members opposing same. The gallery ultimately had to be cleared.

MAY DAY ABROAD.

April 27. In view of a movement for a general strike on May Day numerous military preparations are being made in Paris.
 April 28. The French Cabinet has prohibited the processions and assemblages in the streets arranged for May Day.
 April 30. Despite the great preparations made by workers for demonstrations on May Day M. Clemenceau announces that he will assume responsibility for the maintenance of order which he does not think will be disturbed.

May 2. Paris was in an excited state yesterday morning, by 11 a. m. 120 people had been arrested for congregating in the streets and refusing to move on. The crowd stoned the Chateau d'Eau the police charged and arrested 10. The Provences up to the present are untroubled.
 May 2. Many scuffles occurred between the Police and the crowd in Paris yesterday several police charges were made and once the Police were stoned they replied by firing in the air. The Place de Republique was cleared by cavalry, both the troops and the Police were most discreetly handled and few persons have been injured the total arrests amount to 700.
 May 3. The May Day demonstrations in Berlin, Vienna, Rome and Madrid passed off quietly.
 May 3. 150 of those arrested in Paris have been detained in custody including 70 foreigners mostly Russians, the others have been released, 19 Policemen were injured and 60 persons have been treated in the Hospital.

ANGLO-TURKISH DISPUTE.

REINFORCEMENTS FOR EGYPT.
 H. M. S. "MINERVA"
 April 28. Sir Edward Grey speaking in the House of Commons yesterday stated that Lord Cromer considers it desirable that reinforcements should be sent to Egypt in view

of the unrest there which is partly due to the action of the Porte on the Egyptian Turkish Frontier.

April 28. Three Companies of Infantry which are now in Crete have left to rejoin the Battalion at Cairo. Further reinforcements for Egypt consist of U Battery of Artillery, the Infantry Battalion and a battalion of infantry probably now at Malta. This will make the Egyptian garrison up to 5,000 British troops.

April 28. The British Cabinet have considered the Sinai question and have decided to despatch H. M. S. "Minerva" to England to investigate the removal of the boundary pillars, meanwhile negotiations are proceeding both in London and Constantinople.

April 28. The "Times" in an article regret to say that the situation which the Sultan of Turkey has wondrously created has become grave, and mentions a report that the Turks have servants and seized two others. They attacked the Government office in the town of Thala but were repulsed by the Europeans losing 12 killed and 10 wounded.

TIBET.

April 30. The "Times" correspondent at Peking telegraphs that the Anglo-Chinese Agreement embodying the Chinese admission to the Tibetan Convention was signed on Friday. The negotiations however were concluded on the 24th inst.

May 1. Reuters Agent has informed that the Treaty recently signed at Peking is simply a declaration of China's adhesion to the Liass Treaty.

THE BUDGET SURPLUS.
