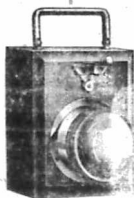

GERMANY'S SUPPLIES.

Process of Exhaustion.

A NEUTRAL VIEW.

The New York 'World' publishes, from the London correspondent, a statement on the economic position and outlook of Germany. The dispatch runs:— A neutral resident of Rotterdam, who speaks with complete up-to-date knowledge of the situation of Germany, writes an interesting account of the economic position at this moment and his prognosis for next year. His statements are not based on conjecture, but on first-hand knowledge and practical experience. He says:—

So complete Germany's economic position in the matter of food supply, present and prospective, you must divide the population into four classes. First, there is the agricultural class of 20,000,000. These are fed all right, because there is no shortage on food that can prevent the class who raise the food from getting their country as long as it is there. This leaves about 25 millions of population who are not fed by the pressure.

There consist of numbers of the industrial class not working for the industrial class—miners, shipbuilders, and so on. There is a great deal of wheat, and so on, but to 2,200 calories per day, 2,600 being the average and normal amount. On this life can be maintained, without any help from Great Britain is 4,200 calories per day. This is going to be in the future? Last year Germany had a poor cereal harvest. They imported 9,000,000 tons from Holland. They imported about 600,000 tons from Rumania. Of the 9,000,000 tons of the wheat imported, about 5,000,000, which, with imports, left the balance remained with the growers. The wheat yield from this is a bread ration of 2,200 calories per day, of which 50 per cent, 2,000 calories per day, will go to the people.

This year's harvest looks like being a good one. Fifteen million tons of cereals in the normal harvest, and all normal crops. There are considerable demands, I reckon they will get that done. Before the war, Germany had that is not the critical point. When 25,000,000 cattle, which was at hand, had been used for breeding, milk-cows, and so on, and the balance of 2,000,000,000, were sold, they had a census on April 30, 1914, of 20,000,000. There were 19,000,000 in the list, of which 4,000,000 were being slaughtered. The balance of 15,000,000 cattle for consumption, two-year-olds and consequently not still less favorable, as the pig position is an immense proportion of pigs owing to the shortage of fodder.
