## ARRIVAL OF RUSSIAN AND ITALIAN.

The arrival at Balaklava of the Russian and Italian contingents, whose members are being transported to the front, is regarded as a political signpost, as the presence of the Allies will probably precipitate the decision of the Allies as regards the attitude on that war which remains to be decided.

Simultaneously it indicates the immediate of a general offensive by the Allies against Bulgaria.

It is known that the British troops in the theatre occupy the right bank of the Dnieper and that although of the Allied British positions stretch from the Gulf of Orfano to Lake Dobruja. Here the line is dominated by the French under General Comans to the front of Epirus.

There are three routes leading to the Dnieper: the first by the Struma valley, the open country between the third and the

## BRITAIN AND PEAKE.

### Pronouncement by the Premier.

An important pronouncement regarding war was made in the House of Commons recently by the Prime Minister, Mr. Lloyd George. Sir W. P. Ryan (Lancashire) member of the North Salford called attention to a statement by Herr von Helmreich (German) the effect that Germany had not been ready to negotiate for some time past. Mr. Ryan said that the British and French had replied to the German offer by Mr. Asquith, in reply, emphasized that the British were not prepared to agree to peace except on terms which were intolerable or humiliating to some of the Allies. (Cheers)

The suggestion that Britain influenced the Entente to accept an armistice, was also made by Mr. Asquith, added had not been suggested officially.

## "SUBMARINE LINER."

### Arrival at German Port.

Boston's *Standard* correspondent quotes a Bremen telegraph despatch with the serial that when the submarine left Brest on the 17th it was reported to be carrying a large quantity of war material, but it was stated that the submarine was not a German one.
