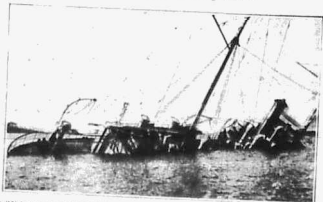

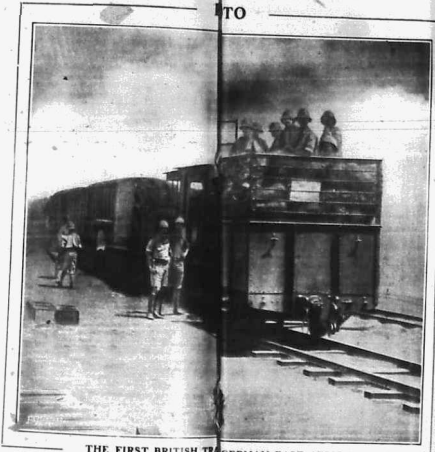

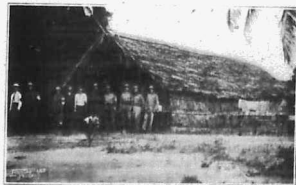


THE FIRST BRITISH TRAIN IN GERMAN EAST AFRICA

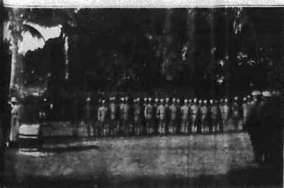
