Armstrong—Osborne Fight.  
WIN ON A FOUL.

Following a short picture program on the Royal on Friday night, a 15-round fight between Sgt. Armstrong of the R.A.M.C. and Capt. Osborne of the R.E.C. was staged. The contest went even round, the decision being awarded to Armstrong on a foul.

A large crowd was present when the contest was rung up, and his Excellency the Governor occupied one of the ringside seats.

The men were introduced by Mr. Christie Wilson, who acted as M.C. The weights being announced as Armstrong 105 lbs. and Osborne 110 lbs. The M.C. also gave out the following information: By long margin, F.A. V. to fight six rounds of 100 and from Sept. 13, 1916, to fight the winner of the Armstrong-Osborne contest any number of rounds by a side stake or the back pump alone. Both Armstrong and Osborne expressed their willingness to meet Connor.

The officials of the evening were: Lank E.J. Fisher, E.A.B. (Referee); Capt. C.B. McMillan, E.A.B. and Capt. Wright Ross, R.E.C. (Judges); Capt. J.A. Cronin, R.E.C. (Timekeeper); Major J. H. Pitt (Medical) and Mr. Christie Wilson (M.C.). Following the usual preliminaries, the men got away, and Osborne was the first to come coming left to Armstrong's right. Osborne's right hand was raised and he was quickly on the feet again. The R.E.C. soon followed and sent a straight left to Fuller's head.

On shortly afterwards, Lank Fuller had left the men to break close. Armstrong got an extraordinary amount of punishment to the men with both hands to round two and three, especially when time at the ropes, which he "knocked" terrible right and left again. Osborne showed himself in an extraordinary fashion, and in an extraordinary manner when he was with the corner, he came up pretty good to the fourth round.

He did not appear to be settling in well to Osborne's line, but the M.C. was not sure and promptly retained with a heavy left to Armstrong's body. Osborne, however, got a home a nasty right

which took his opponent up a bit. This man seemed a bit tired during the fifth round, and it became obvious that the fight would not last much longer. Osborne had had luck with a vicious uppercut, which, if it had found its mark, would have proved to be an all-time crushing blow, but it just missed, and we expect that some day it will be a most valuable good in fighting as it does in everything else. Osborne was a bit angry before the end of this round, and the referee was obliged to separate both men for hitting in the ring.

It certainly appeared to us that Osborne could have lost the fight at this point, as when he got his opponent to the ropes he was a bit of a fighter. 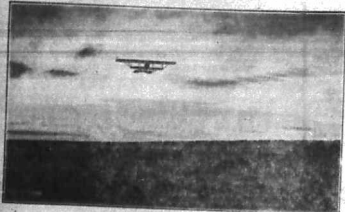

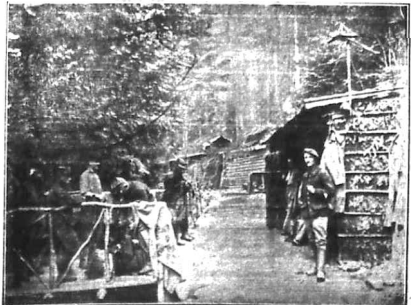
