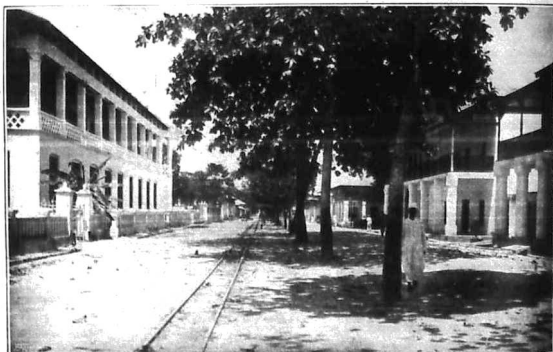

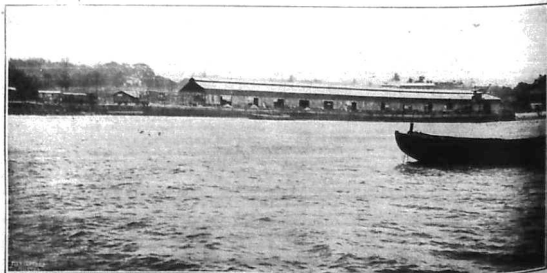

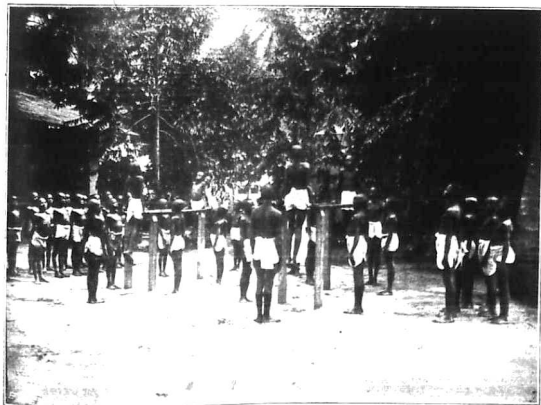

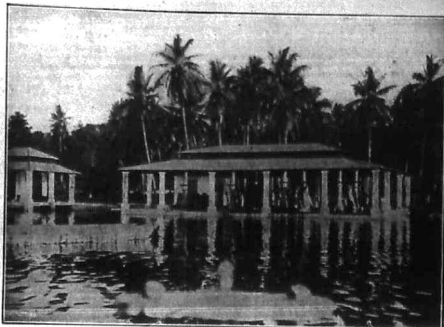

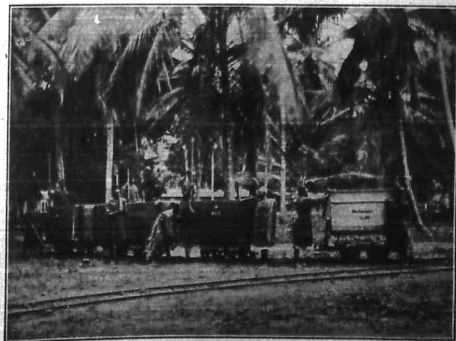
THE RAILWAY STATION IN TANGA
