What is and what is not an illegal gratuity has been occupying the attention of the old country for some little time and as a result of the debated opinions on the question the Prevention of Corruption Act has been added to the Common Law of England.

A Correspondent writes: No close is the financial connection of the Federal States in Germany with the expenditure of the various German States.

If the impunity which is meted out to the magistrates and the judges and the whole principle of justice without fear and favour allowed to fall to the ground, the Government can be accused of tampering with the morality consequent on a police officer can there be any question of tampering with the morality of the State even through social sources?

Discarding From Weakness or Strength.

A correspondent submits to 'Knave' the following:— "Amongst the bridge players I have met, opinions as to the merits of discarding from weakness or from strength are very oddly divided."

A shub would show strength in clubs.

A heart would show strength in diamonds. A shub is obviously more advantageous in two aces out of three, than the strong discard. On the above, the well known Bridge Expert remarks as follows:—

The reasoning described in this letter is quite a well-known one, and, if my memory is correct, goes by the name of the "French" method, but to what extent it is practiced in the Gallic people I am unable to say. The idea underlying it is, of course, to show the weak suit by a single discard without weakening it in the process. But this is accomplished, as the quoted letter points out, in two cases out of every three. It is a wholly artificial signal, however, leading being rather a confusing one to read, and this, too, faces the player who is not versed in the art.

The discard from weakness, which is now so universally practiced, may one take it for granted in club openings, has this great merit simplicity. Nothing can be more logical than to suppose that a player who has an opportunity of casting a superior card from his hand will select one from a weak suit in which he has no hope of making a trick, rather than from a suit which he has a chance of establishing if it is to him; and although the line of reasoning does not invariably hold good, it is sufficient to give the convention a logical basis.

A can make absolutely certain of saving the game by leading his small diamond, and this is according to the best card to lead. If the queen is with Z, no harm is done by leading queen as Z because he (Z) can only hold two more of the suit and A's ace and knave will be the third and fourth rounds respectively. If the queen is with B, on the other hand, an extra trick is gained by leading a small one; and if he had only two diamonds originally, the best card to lead is dummy's weakness.

It is not particularly difficult to remember in clubs, which will be the best thing possible for A. It should be noted that the spade suit is blocked by dummy, for if it takes over the King or queen with the ace, A's advantage comes good on the third round.

SHIPPING SWEET POTATOES. In West India final experiments have been tried as to the commercial possibilities of shipping sweet potatoes from the West Indies to England. We give the details—

At a Meeting of Planters at Barbados Dr. Morris, C.M.S., reviewed the efforts already made. He pointed out that when the matter was started last year an appeal was made to a few planters only to join in the experiment.

An account of the profits arising from the shipment of the produce from Barbados to this Island. Dr. Morris was enabled to add that allowing 41/2 per acre as the cost of cultivation, the net amount the planter should receive, according to the available data, is approximately to about 29/ to 30/ per acre.

In reporting on the trial shipments, the Superintendent of the Government Station states as follows:— I forward a memorandum on the results of the trial shipment of sweet potatoes shipped to Mombasa, James Philip & Co., of London, to enable the close of the last and the beginning of this year.

As showing what an additional gain of 50/ per acre can be made by growing sweet potatoes, we append the average gross value of crops of some of the principal crops, for the year 1905, as follows:—

Directions for packing. Potatoes intended for shipment to the English market should be dug on the Monday preceding the day on which the ship is to be packed in barrels. The barrels should have about one dozen equal distant clean-out holes of 1 1/2 inch diameter.

We understand that Mr. de Crespigny gave instructions to his Kiviro Native servant to remove a case of flour from out of the hut into his tent, which the boy at first refused to do but afterwards consented, as the native, however, was entering the tent he must have stepped back and encountered the blade of a pig sticking spear which Mr. de Crespigny, who was following him, was swinging in his hand at the time.

A Bill to Amend the Diseases of Animals Ordinance 1906.

To take effect from 1st February 1908. The Diseases of Animals Ordinance 1906 and shall be read as one with the Diseases of Animals Ordinance 1906, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Where any person is seen or found committing, or is suspected of committing, an offence against the Principal Ordinance or a breach of any rule promulgated, order or direction under the said Ordinance, a Veterinary Officer or Inspector appointed under the said Ordinance or a Police Officer may without warrant stop and detain him; and if his name and address be not known, the Officer may apprehend or detain him, and he shall give them to the satisfaction of such officer.

Where any person obstructs or impedes or attempts to obstruct or impede a Veterinary Officer or Inspector appointed under the Principal Ordinance or a Police Officer in the execution of his duty under the said Ordinance or under the Principal Ordinance, or a Veterinary Officer, Inspector or Police Officer, or such officer shall on conviction be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 12 months or to a fine not exceeding 1000 rupees or to both.

A person apprehended under this Ordinance shall be taken with all practicable speed before a Magistrate and shall not be detained without a warrant longer than is necessary for the purpose.

Where a Veterinary Officer, an Inspector appointed under the Principal Ordinance or a Police Officer may seize any animal in respect of which he may have reason to suspect that an offence against the Principal Ordinance or a breach of any rule promulgated, order or direction under the said Ordinance is being committed, and may remove such animal to a pound, or to any other place selected by a Veterinary Officer and there detain such animal subject to the orders of a Magistrate.

Wherever any animal shall have been seized and detained under the provisions of the preceding sub-section, the Magistrate shall issue a warrant for such animal with all practicable speed.
