FEEDING THE GUNS.

Colossal Task of Maintaining Supplies.

THE HUMAN ELEMENT

Specially to "E.A. Standard."
It had been proved beyond the possibility of question that a modern trench warfare, with its complex defenses, requiring in its prosecution the fire of the heaviest guns of all kinds, it is absolutely necessary to destroy this hostile system ever an hour, so far as possible in order to give the infantry a chance of success. Their destruction can only be accomplished by a heavy artillery of heavy howitzer or shell, and consequently, during the preliminary bombardment, the artillery remains for a while inactivated, the question of the supply of ammunition being a matter of the most serious importance. During this period a battery of howitzers may dispose of as much as 70 or 80 tons of shell in the course of recent operations; this figure has frequently been exceeded. 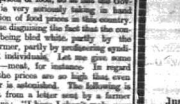
