MOSQUITO PEST.

Stringent Rules for Suppression Gazetted.

PENALTIES PROVIDED

As a lately announced by the Acting Director in exercise of the power conferred on him by the East African (Tobacco Ordinance of 1915), has issued the following rules with reference to the suppression of mosquitoes in Nairobi:

- 1. These Rules may be cited as "The Mosquito (Suppression) Rules, Nairobi, 1917."
2. The Tobacco Rules dated 24th of October, 1915, are hereby repealed.
3. The Medical Officer of Health, Sanitary Inspector, or any person authorized in writing by the Medical Officer of Health shall have power to enter any lands within the limits of a 1/2 mile radius of the Medical Officer of Health and may thereupon cause any person to be removed or to be taken to any place of safety...

GERMANS IN AFRICA.

Questions for Peace Congress.

The recent conference in London under the auspices of the Inter-Allied Society was very valuable. We have their views on the subject before us. It is not possible to discuss the European territories involved in the war, and more or less other than as to the principles which must govern the African lands. We must also begin to think seriously about the future of the African lands. At Glasgow Mr. Lloyd George did not claim the conquered German colonies for the Allies. He suggested that their disposition should be decided by the Peace Congress, which should give full weight to the sentiments of the inhabitants. Some speakers at the Conference seem to have assumed that this subsidiary consideration is a remedy. We can, so we are content for Mr. George's words. The merits and demerits of internationalism must be fully analyzed by the Peace Congress, which will act, not as a substitute for distributing body but a gathering of the nations for a better ordering of the world. Though there were differences of opinion at the Conference as to the system which the German colonies should be governed, there was general agreement as to three principles which any system of government must adopt—there must be no forced labor, no raising of black armies, and no obstructing traffic or other economic discriminations between nations and nations. We are not so optimistic as we believe that these rules will be justly without a severe struggle, but justice is very evidently on the march, and we are confident that it will triumph at the Peace Congress. Germany, whose commercial empire in Africa is to be charged with its inevitable doom, would do well to make themselves, whether Germany has produced a conference of the same quality and spirit as that held recently. By a recognition there is to be had a report of a speech by Her Derburg. Her Derburg has the reputation of being an uttering of a liberal view and moderate mind, and he has the usual Secretary. 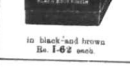

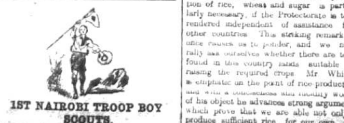
