Hill, who had not run so fastly the preceding week on the same ground finished ahead of Donohue, but just failed to qualify for the final round. An exciting finish in the mile saw H. Owen, who was twice mile runner at the meeting, the improved runner P. Hodge by a couple of yards, the time being a fraction of a second better than four and a half minutes. It must have been a very close race, for the performance was not the equal of what he accomplished in his best days.

BOVING EXTRAORDINARY.
 Whether Captain has done his best is responsible for many of the variations in the form of our present day riders. They will not account for all of them, however, and very often the superiority of the opposing side has been the main factor. There was a very remarkable bowling achievement the other day.
