World's News by Cable.

The Near East.

Turkish Persecution.

Pitiable Condition of Macedonians.

Strict Emquiry Being Held.

(Rector's Special to East African Standard) London.

Thousands of Macedonian refugees fleeing from the persecution of the Turks are pouring into Bulgaria and Greece, entreating the Government of those countries as they are conditionally arriving without any means of subsistence. Many are in a pitiable condition, begging public sympathy. They have informed the Bulgarian Presser that they have information as to the names and families of their relatives in Macedonia. The Presser has promised to do everything in his power for them.

Rector's Agent at Constantinople states that Sultan Bey now admits that three were cases of "Macedonian" in Macedonia. A large enquiry is being held with a view to punishment of the culprits. Already one District Governor of Bulgaria has been dismissed and a military officer will be court-martialed.

King Alfonso.

In Polo Finals.

(Rector's Special to East African Standard) London.

King Alfonso is playing polo again in the semi-finals for the Cuban Cup. He is playing with the Right team, are qualifying for the final King Alfonso's horse which is much admired. The competitors in the tournament are crack teams.

Lloyd George's Politics.

(Rector's Special to East African Standard) London.

Mr. Lloyd George speaking at Porthmadoc, Wales, referring to Old Age Pensions, hoped within a year to introduce a scheme to provide for persons who broke down in health before reaching pensionable age. They must first settle with the State, he said, before making their own arrangements and Home Rule Speaking on Women's Suffrage, he urged women to show restraint and self-control.

The "Terra Nova."

Travelling Under Sail.

(Rector's Special to East African Standard) London.

With reference to the "Terra Nova" Capt Scott and on the end of this month she could be expected at Cape Town. The "Terra Nova" was travelling principally under sail which makes the date of her arrival uncertain.

Latham's Prize Flight.

(Rector's Special to East African Standard) London.

Latham has won the 10,000 franc prize for the flight from Orleans to Paris in Montgolfiers in 185 minutes travelling Paris.

Anglo-American Fisheries Arbitration.

(Rector's Special to East African Standard) London.

At the Hague the arguments in the Anglo-American Arbitration on the Newfoundland fisheries which have been proceeding since the 2nd of June, have at length been concluded. Judgment is expected to be given on the 1st of September.

Aviation.

(Rector's Special to East African Standard) London.

It is officially announced that Drossel at the Lanark meeting attained an altitude of 7,750 feet which is the world's record, the previous record being 5,500 feet reached by Tyok in Biscuits two weeks ago.

LATHES—Drossel's ascent was most daring. He was lost amidst ominous clouds. Thousands of people listened with great anxiety after he had passed for any sound of the aeroplane's motor and searched for him fruitlessly. Drossel was over an hour descending. He finally landed at a place fifteen miles distant. He said it was intensely odd after reaching 6,000 feet high when progress was slowest.

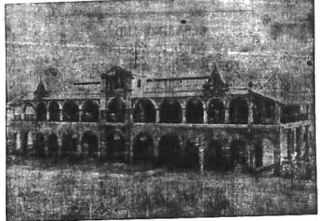

World's News by Cable. Brussels Exhibition. Will Remain Open to Public. Important British Losses. Further Details of Fire.

(Bestor's Special to East African Standard) London. In the Brussels Exhibition the Italian section was the property destroyed by the fire. Eight other sections suffered slight damage and all the documents of the judging committee were burnt. The executive has decided that those parts which have not been destroyed remain open to the public.

The most important British losses at the fire include treasures loaned from the Victoria Albert Museum, also collections of china and tapestry, decorative furniture, books and numerous pictures. According to a British official's account the Exhibition was at the time of the fire in the most successful and prosperous of its history. It was a great success and the British section was the most popular. It was a great success and the British section was the most popular.

Gold Still Buried in Ruins. (Bestor's Special to East African Standard) London. All the goldsmith's work which was almost entirely in gold, is still buried in the ruins of the Belgian jewelry section.

De Beers Model Mine Destroyed. (Bestor's Special to East African Standard) London. In the jewelry section also was De Beers model of a mine with the blue-ground and other realistic accessories imported from Kimberley, including an exhibit of recent diamonds belonging to De Beers. Everything is in ruins but the stones, it is believed, were packed up in a safe. A De Beers representative considers that these are unharmed but they cannot be recovered for four or five days till the debris are cooler, although some mining is felt for the safety of the stones.

Wax Figures Fed the Fire. British Staff Worked Admirably. Loss of Diamond Exhibits is Colossal. (Bestor's Special to East African Standard) London. It was noticed during the fire that the Wax mannikens of Brussels dressmakers added the flames. The members of the British staff worked strenuously and calmly, saving many valuable British exhibits, especially the pieces of the Turin Exhibition. The Mats says that the damage to the diamond and jewelry exhibits is colossal. One estimate of the total loss is £10,000, but this at present is not confirmed.

World's News by Cable. Irish Faction Fight. Hot Time in Bantry. Chief of Police and Others Injured.

A fierce fight has taken place in Bantry, County Cork, owing to three Members of Parliament of the same party attempting to make speeches on a platform which was bombarded. The three Members who were injured in the fracas, including the Chief of Police. Several police charges were made and finally a hundred constables took the Members of Parliament safely to the train. Much fighting went on between the two Irish parties in the streets.

Labour Unrest. General Strikes in Europe. Men Rejecting Advice of Leaders. A Foreshadow of the Reign of Anarchy.

Considerable anxiety is felt at the unrest in the labour world throughout Europe. A shipbuilding and railway trouble is threatening Britain; the shipbuilding strike in Germany is assuming ever increasing proportions; railway men in France are fighting for the minimum wages on all the lines; and in the most serious outlook in the Balkan strike in favour of shorter hours. The gravest feature of these troubles is the growing disposition of the men to reject the advice of their leaders and the indications that the movement are getting out of the hands of the organisations which heretofore controlled and directed them.

"Terra Nova" Sighted. The "Terra Nova," Capt. Scott's ship for his Antarctic Expedition, has been sighted. "Larsen"—the "Terra Nova" has arrived. All well. She was delayed by taking magnetic observations.

Dernburg Leaves for Japan. It is reported from Berlin that Herr Dernburg has started overland for Vladivostok en route for Tokio.

Japan Floods. Heavy Death Roll. The official report of the Japan Floods states that 1,112 persons are dead or missing and that thousands are homeless.

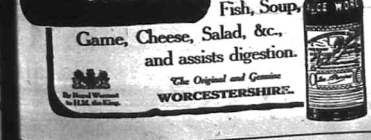
