World's News by Cable.

Gun Accident at Balmoral.

(Editor's Special to "East African Standard") London.

His Majesty's shooting party at Balmoral was unfortunately marred by a gun accident which caused considerable alarm but luckily was not serious. A gun had gone off accidentally and Lord Kilmarnock who was standing forty yards away was hit in the face by three bullets and in the arm by two. A gullie who was in the line of fire was also hit.

LETTER.—The accident to Lord Kilmarnock was caused by the sportsman in the next butt accidentally getting the grouse in a line with Lord Kilmarnock just as they were crossing between them. He was greatly upset by the accident, ceased firing and sympathized with Lord Kilmarnock who was hit. Lord Kilmarnock resumed shooting but the other sportsman declined to continue.

Religious Societies in Turkey.

Reuters agent at Constantinople reports that, as the result of the prolonged negotiations between the United States Ambassador and the Government, exemption from the provisions of the Ottoman Law controlling Associations has been secured.

All American institutions, religious, educational, and benevolent are now recognized as legally registered.

The decision applies to similar institutions of other nations. The decision is of considerable importance in as much as it affects three hundred American institutions alone.

Socialist Views.

Reuters' Agent at Copenhagen reports that the International Socialist congress, which was attended by 887 delegates, resolved that unemployment will only disappear when capitalism disappears.

They demanded a general and compulsory insurance by the authorities against unemployment at the expense of the owners of means.

Earthquake Recorded by Seismographs.

A violent earthquake was recorded by British seismographs, it is estimated to have been at a distance of 800 miles and lasted an hour.

Canada and United States.

Canada has done her part and it was now time the United States took the initiative in negotiating a treaty on equitable terms, as Canada would nevertheless go on thriving even if the United States did not move in the matter. He ridiculed the argument that such a treaty would endanger British preferences.

Turkey Getting Angry.

Greece has strongly protested against the non-recognition of the Turkish boycott of Greek goods. The Turkish Press condemns the weakness of the Powers in connection with the election of Cretans to the Greek Parliament and describe Greece and Bulgaria as disturbers of the Peace and malicious neighbours, adding that these countries need a sharp lesson.

Portugal Supporting Spain.

The Portuguese cabinet is preparing to promulgate measures against religious congregations on similar lines to those of Spain.

KILINDINI HARBOUR. Question of Improvements.

OPTIMISTIC TRADE REPORT.

The following letter has been received by the Secretary of the Chamber of Commerce in reply to a request for information regarding the question of the Kilindini Pier—

The question of a permanent deep water pier for Kilindini Harbour was originally put forward in 1897 by Sir George Whitcomb...

The site of this pier, which was to be situated between the Kilindini and Telegraph Piers, was not however approved as it was considered that it might so affect the currents and "tidal" in the harbour that shipping might be seriously impeded.

The question came up again in 1903 when Major Pringle, R.E., Government Inspector of Railways, was sent by the Public Works Office to make a report on the Uganda Railway.

Finally a modification of this scheme was adopted which is what has recently been completed. Objectively it was estimated to cost 400,000 and included a deep water berth for steamships...

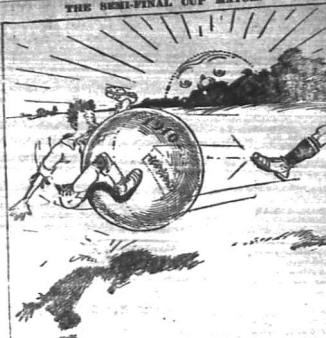
