A SETTLER'S COMPLAINT  
British Freedom  
ANNULS OF LAND CONCESSION IN B.E.A.

To the Editor "E.A. STANDARD."  
I am a settler in B.E.A. and a British subject. I would like to voice my protest against the land concessions granted to the Swedish Company, who are present making representations for the annulment of the last few days. In your columns you have supported the scheme in as far as it brings capital to this country, which might otherwise be diverted to Germany, but the sum which the company intend exporting on this scheme 250,000 cannot surely carry much in the way of capital, when it is a tenth of our daily War Expenditure and further, there are in B.E.A. today many Britons who have fought for the freedom of this soil and to whom it is as yet denied the opportunity of investing their capital in the country. Why then should the Government be given rights which are being denied to-day to Britain's own sons, and be allowed to make profits out of British soil and labour while our own men are still fighting and giving their blood for the Empire?  
I think it is worthy the annals of land concession in this country, we will find several instances of foreign influence at home procuring titles to almost our best and what guarantee can have, that the company will not eventually receive title to any lands which are better chosen by this Government is unable to fulfil his financial obligations. After all, "Foreigners are not to be trusted" and we all know the delightful advantage of having someone to "pull the strings" and can cast the blame on their shoulders. It is unreasonable to ask "allies" Britain and the British Government to be the greatest benefactors to the happy hunting ground for foreign men, where they enjoy all the privileges and most of the benefits of the British Empire. I am sure you will find a space in your valuable paper for this letter.

STAMP OUT DISEASE.**

The following letter has been received  
from the Director of Agriculture for public  
information.

Sir,—I have the honour to inform you  
that a meeting of local stockowners was  
held at Nairobi on 19th inst. to discuss  
the question of cattle movement in  
areas infested with East Coast Fever  
and the measures to be taken to prevent  
the disease from spreading. It was  
decided that the following resolutions  
should be adopted:—(1) That the  
present regulations only contain re-  
quirements for the movement of cattle  
from infested areas to clean areas, and  
that the movement of cattle from clean  
areas to infested areas should be  
prohibited. (2) That the dipping of  
cattle before movement from clean areas  
to infested areas should be compulsory.  
The following resolutions were also  
passed:—(3) That the dipping of

that where possible one of the signatures  
on such certificate shall be a person who is  
able to be followed by the movement.  
There is therefore a certificate signed by the owner  
or his representative, certifying that no  
case of East Coast Fever has occurred  
within a certain area for a period of 14  
days of the certificate, on the farm or place  
from which such cattle are to be moved, and  
that the cattle to be moved have at least  
two broad tooth and have been recently  
dipped every 72 hours for a period of  
two months prior to the date of the cer-  
tificate.

**MOVING CATTLE.**

3. The dip analysis certificate signed by  
the Government Analyst, or any person  
authorised in writing, showing that the  
dip analysis furnished by the owner or his  
representative on the case may have  
been taken at regular intervals of 14 days  
for a period of two months prior to the  
proposed movement, and have been found  
to contain no case.

4. That the equivalent of  
0.72 per cent. ammonia oxide in the form  
of urea of soda, that is to say, five con-  
secutive samples taken at intervals of  
14 days shall show that the dip has not  
been used for 10 per cent. below stand-  
ard strength during the last dipping.

Cattle moving under this Rule must  
enter the area free from East Coast Fever  
within 72 hours of the last dipping.

Note.—Only transport cattle recognized  
as immune to East Coast Fever will be per-  
mitted to move to and from an area in-  
fested with East Coast Fever and an area  
free from East Coast Fever.
