**ENEMY PROPERTY
A Zanzibar Decision
INTERESTING CASE CONCERNING
GERMAN CLUB**

An interesting order was made by Judge Munro in the Zanzibar High Court last week in connection with an application by the Custodians of Enemy Property under the Trading with the Enemy Decree of 1916. Mr. Mead was for the Custodian, and the Court ruled as follows:

"This is an application by the Custodians of Enemy Property for a winding order under the Trading with the Enemy Decree, 1916.

It appears that by a document purporting to be a mortgage and dated 1st October, 1910, and made between Alfred Haugler, Albert Max, Emil Eisenthal and Herman Weismann (the latter Committee of the German Club, Zanzibar) of the one part and firms carrying on business in Zanzibar, of the other part, certain land as a dwelling house situated at Mwanza, was mortgaged to the German Community as a Club was charged in Company, with the payment of Rs. 4,000, and interest at 6 per cent per annum.

The documents in possession of Wm. Hittmann and Company, were the Africans Handled Gesellschaft, who acted as Hittmann's solicitors. The Africans firm are in possession of the land.

The land and building referred to were acquired by the Zanzibar Government under the Land Acquisition Decree, 1906, and the price thereof was paid into the Court for Zanzibar and Pemba between the Government and the Africans.

The mortgage and other documents were just recently discovered and it appears

therefrom that the persons who are ultimately entitled to the money are Hittmann and Company.

The present application is that the debt due to them be wadded in the Custodians of Enemy Property.

There is only one difficulty. The deed is not registered.

Under section 8 (1) of the Registration of Documents Decree, 1908—

"No document executed after the issue of this Decree, purporting or operating to create, declare, assign, limit or discontinue any right, title, or interest whether vested or contingent, by, in, or over immovable property in our Dominions, except such documents as are of a testamentary nature, shall affect any immovable property comprised therein or be received as evidence in any civil proceedings or any transaction affecting that property unless it has been registered as hereinafter prescribed."

The question therefore arises whether, as Mr. Mead contends for the Custodians, the document can be put in only as evidence of a debt without assertion of mortgage rights, or whether the absence of registration completely invalidates the document as a piece of evidence.

The point is covered by authority. In *Uthmaniyah v. Elshaban* it was held that an unregistered bond, containing a personal undertaking to repay money borrowed and also a hypothecation of land above Rs. 100 in value as security, could be used to enforce the personal obligation. And in *Vani and others v. Best Basappa* it was held that an unregistered mortgage bond for Rs. 100 and upwards might be admissible to prove the simple debt, though it was inadmissible to prove any right to the property affected by it.

I believe I decided this point in the same sense in the Court some time ago but I am unable to refer to the case.

There is a covenant to pay in the document in the present case and I hold therefore that the document is admissible to prove the simple debt.

The order is made on prayer exactly the debt under the document being the Custodians of Enemy Property.

The costs of this application will be out of the fund.

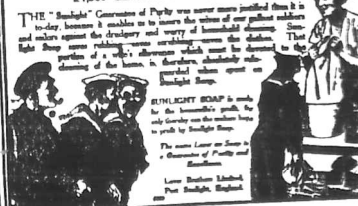
