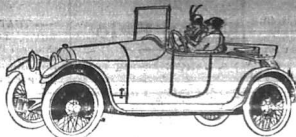

TOWN PLANNING
Report of Meeting of Sub-Committee
THE HOSPITAL SITE

At the monthly general meeting of the Municipal Committee held at the Municipal Office on Wednesday, August 5, the following report was presented by the Town Planning Sub-Committee.

J. McDona plots 129/3 East Court Road.
 Resurvey of bank premises. Approved.

It was pointed out that, in giving up a width of 10.6m. at the back of the plot to be situated into a width of 40.1m. road, less than one-third of the plot remained suitable upon. It was decided that in the case where the plans of a building were submitted for approval, a condition should be attached to the approval requiring the applicant to provide a portion of the plot for the purpose of road widening the portion indicated may be required in the event of the road being widened.

Land Office Letter.
 Following upon Min. 16 of May 1914, 1917, a letter from the East

Office was read with reference to the sub-division of the land into an Estate (Plot 187) approved by the District Council on the above date, supporting the intention of obtaining a licence to the width of the portion of the sanitary lane abutting upon plot 477/3 from 10 feet to 15 feet.

It was decided to ask the Land Office to endeavour to obtain the extra width and, if possible, to purchase the whole owner to delete plot No. 31 to obtain an extra width of 25 feet from an extra width of 40 feet outside road and also on the grounds that the Committee deprecates the sale of plots of so small an area.

Following upon Min. 5, item 3, of February 5th, it was decided to instruct the General Manager for getting the reversion of the land of the waterworks reserve adjoining the Nursing Association's plot for the purpose of a Town Hospital.

The General Manager agreed to meet the sub-committee on this question.

Prof. Simpson's Scheme.
 Following upon Min. 4 of General Meeting of 7th May, and letter from the Chief Secretary, was read detailing the decisions which had been made with regard to the various items of Professor Simpson's scheme and detailing the Committee's protest against the proposed adoption of the scheme.

It was resolved that the Registrar should get out a plan showing what the lines of town-planning which have been definitely fixed; and that the Chairman of the Chief Secretary be informed of the resolutions of the committee on this subject.

Following upon Min. 6/7 of General Meeting of 2nd July, it was agreed to recommend that until a complete drainage scheme for the whole township was prepared, the D.P.W. must remain the Drainage Authority.

The D.P.W. could not promise to let the committee have this, this financial year.

A meeting was held on Monday 29th July, to consider the reports on Private Estates sections of the Public Health Bill, and if it was possible, the Town Planning Bill.

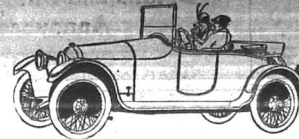

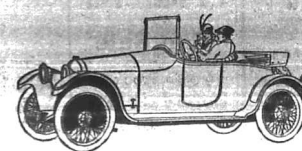

Victorious Advance on Front of
25 Miles
1,000 TANKS LEAD THE WAY
OVER 24,000 PRISONERS AND HUNDREDS OF
GUNS CAPTURED
 (EVENING BULLETIN'S AGENCY.)

LONDON, Aug. 9.—The *Dunlop* reports further progress in the big movement which was begun in the early part of the month and by the 1st Army under General Haig, the British 4th Army under General Rawlinson, and the Canadian, Australian, and New Zealand Divisions, assisted by the American forces, in the Somme valley.

The Allies have taken upwards of 14,000 prisoners; the number of guns captured cannot yet be estimated.

The enemy has continued to evacuate his forward positions in the Lys Valley; our line has advanced between the Leuze and Douro Rivers, north-westward of Morville, to a maximum depth of 2,000 yards. We hold Lecon, Le Courbusin, Quentin-le-Petit, Pasaut and Lézard.

We advanced our line a short distance for upwards of 1,000 yards on the front northward of Kemmel, taking over 30 prisoners.

Smashed by Drum Fire
 Our troops, accompanied with British Headquarters, writing to-day to the British 4th Army on the subject; this morning's developed into a success, the strategic consequences of which cannot yet be judged. Our tanks drove the enemy from our trench positions and machine-gun posts and enabled our infantry to establish themselves behind our forward line being smashed up by few minutes' drum fire. One Corps alone took 2,000 prisoners in the early morning. One division counted nearly a thousand by six o'clock.
