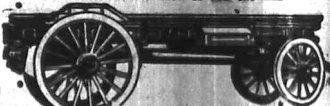

The Entomologist recommends the following mixture to kill the pest:
ARSENITE OF SODA ... 1 lb.
JAGGERI ... 6 lbs.
WATER ... 10 Gallons
Chop up into small pieces, about 1 inch long any green vegetation, weeds, grass, &c. wet this with the above mixture and broadcast liberally. A good plan is to spread the chopped green vegetation on a soil and water with a watering can. The bait is most effective if applied in the evening.

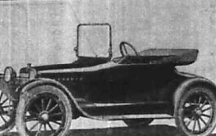

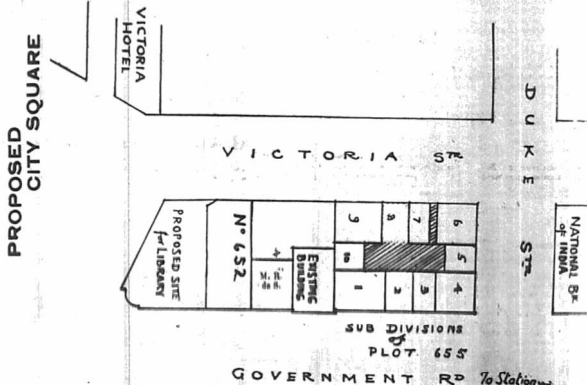

One cannot always accurately remember the exact version of the various articles which have appeared in this interesting paper in the Protectorate. This man was sometimes elevated by the great heights in latitude and longitude. I had opportunity to see the country. He, an active, athletic, fit man, used to football, etc., was now tied to a sedentary occupation and took little or no exercise. I found him nervous and complaining of mental strain. My somewhat liberal suggestion that he was drinking and eating too much for his style of life was not readily received. When he returned he told the country, convinced that the death-cure of the tropics and the elevation was killing him.

The only people who acquiesced when I praised the country were the old hands who came here after some years of life in one or other of the great Dominions. They would work at me, about the truth of my remarks or go on better in their praise. I do not suggest that the great losses and serious illness who don't know a good thing when they see it deserved to miss the opportunity of their lives.

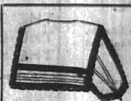

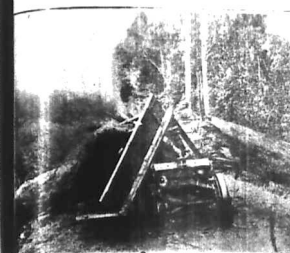

A Simple Trimm Coat

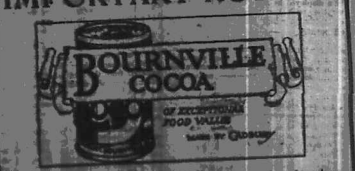

NAIROBI CHAMBER.

An interesting Meeting. A SUMMARY OF WHAT HAPPENED.

The President, Mr. Fletcher, rose to the chair to preside at a meeting of the Chamber of Members.

Although the printed agenda included only the items mentioned above, the Chairman, Mr. Fletcher, thought it better to have a general meeting of the Chamber.

The Sub-Committee found that the Indian labour force in the town of Nairobi is about 7,000, and asked the Chamber to take steps to improve the conditions of the Indian labour force.

Members voted a strong protest against the Chamber, and Mr. A. Wood was deputed to interview the Managing Director on the subject.

Minutes of the meeting were adopted, and a report from the Sub-Committee which has been with the matter. The report reviewed the conditions reported to the Chamber and a vote of thanks to the Chamber was recorded.

A telegram was read from the Member Mr. A. Wood, who was in the support of the Chamber's action.

The question of exchange and currency was brought up in a motion by Mr. H. Hamilton who asked the Chamber to be appointed to go into the matter.

The opinion was expressed that the best way of exchange was to be decided by the Chamber, and that the Chamber should be appointed to find out on what a possible way of exchange was to be decided.

The discussion on the motion to increase in currency notes which contain the date June 15, 1916, a storm of protest.

It was also discussed as to whether the present currency of the Colony should be replaced by the Indian currency, and the Chamber was asked to take steps to improve the conditions of the Indian labour force.
