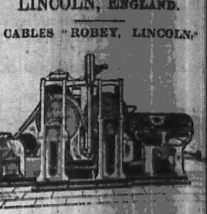

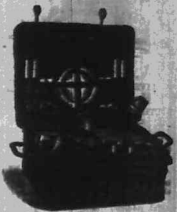

### SETTLERS' CLAIMS Unjust Clause of Land Report

NAIWAUSA CASE. Sir—I wish most strongly to join those of your correspondents who have protested against the injustice of Clause 5 of the British Indian Council's Report to the East Africa Commission. If only this Commission had been formed of a body of popularly elected representatives, how different would this report have been!

In an estimate individually the question of each of the non-British members of the Commission—the official members would of course not benefit under the scheme—it will be seen as one that only of them will be well-served with the words "approve and his money would serve in E.A.A. so that perhaps they do not so thoroughly appreciate with their few fortunate brethren as might be expected.

As C.W.R. points out, it is very hard on the man who has spent Rs. 4/ to Rs. 6/ p.d. for several years, and has had to keep himself and his family in the East Africa Commission, so that he might be deluded from sending his money under the scheme, because it is a landholder. If my delusion was made, and this would probably be considered

an invasion—it should be the man who obtained a commission out of hand (however entitled for his part) not the private, N.C.O. or man who served his commission in the field. The former would have received several hundred pounds more than the latter after several years' service—quite a nice little sum if considered in the light of a bonus.

As things stand at present, they may find homes or the colonies no matter what his possessions in the land of his birth, can come out here and take up land for his own or his family, even if he has been profiting for a year and was unacquainted during the last few months of his service.

### E. A. COINAGE

Suggestions to Avoid the Loss in the Rupee. Sir—As the question of coinage in this country is constantly under discussion I should like to make the following suggestions through the medium of your paper.

That the rupee should be substituted by the English shilling in the coinage of the territories. This I believe would reduce the cost of issuing and circulating a simple unit as follows:

- 1. One million (one lakh) notes.
- 2. One Rupee (1/10th of one shilling) notes.
- 3. 50 cents or one shilling, both to be stamped on one note, but the present 50 cent piece to be kept tender.
- 4. 25 cents or six pence, both to be stamped on one note, but the present 25 cent piece to be kept tender.

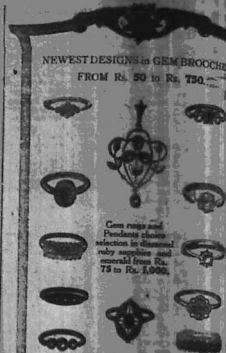
