TROPICAL SUNSHINE

The Effect of the Ultra Violet Rays on the Eyes

Daylight or the solar spectrum is made up of various rays, amongst which is the ultra violet which has a very powerful tropical sunshine and very dangerous to the organs of sight in fact dangerous and so powerful that one may say that it is essentially a modified form of X rays. Although the ultra violet is not essential to vision, it has been asked why it is necessary to protect our eyes from a force we see neither feel nor smell. Nature has furnished custom care to protect our eyes from the light and heat but has apparently given us little or no protection from excessive ultra violet.

Ultra violet interferes with shape of the eye and causes inflammation. The eye endowments to protect vision are slight and delicate. In addition to this when there is a concentration of ultra violet light on the eye there is developed a heat which is not felt. These effects come on several hours after the sun has set. 

We are informed that as a result of disembarking the herd of approximately 100 Cows which were imported for the purpose of supplying the Military Hospitals with milk will come under the Authorities' scrutiny about the end of March at Nairobi, on the same day as the Annual Government Fair. The great majority of these are high grade "Friesians" especially selected on account of their deep milking qualities, and some have yielded up to 25 gallons of milk per day. The milk records for the best cows will be shown in the sale catalogue. Two pedigree bulls were also imported and with the exception of a few calves from Cows recently arrived in East Africa, all those are sent by these bulls and the "in calf" Cows have been carried by them. The animals were tested with Pasteurising prior to shipment from South Africa, and again be tested before they are sold. All the Cows offered are believed to be regular breeders and those which were found to be non-breeders were slaughtered for 7 days after average dressed weight was 250 lbs. One of the best cows from which it will be seen that they are Cows of weight and substance. The land has now been as "disinfectant" for 13 months, and during that period has kept remarkably healthy and free from disease. All these cattle will be on view at Nairobi during March.


