His Indians were charged at the Magistrate's Court yesterday with house breaking and causing hurt. MISSING CABLES

The Editor, E.A. Standard.

Sir—I beg to ask you to kindly give publicity to the following, and would also like you to let me know what steps he takes in the matter.

I send a cablegram to a number of men in India on the 28th December, 1918, and on my receiving the information that the cablegram forwarded by me was not received by the addressee, I wrote a letter to the Postmaster-General, on the 15th May, asking for damages and for return of money paid to the Post Office for transmission. In this letter, the Postmaster-General's letter to me of the 15th May, asked me to forward to him documentary evidence to the effect that the cablegram in question has not been delivered, in order that representations may be made to the Cable Committee, on the subject.

In reply to this letter, on the next day, I replied to the P.M.G. that I was unable to believe that the said cablegram was not transmitted from Nairobi, and that at the time of writing I was unable to lay my hands on the letter received by me from him, and that I requested him to make enquiry at the offices connected with the transmission of the cablegram.

As no reply was received by me till 1st June, I wrote a reminder to the P.M.G., asking him to let me have at least the refund of the money paid (leaving aside for the time, the question of damages) and if possible to go with his engines he might do till I received a reply.

I have to-day received a reply from the P.M.G. in which he encloses a refund for Rs. 16, the charges being paid by me, and adds that the telegraph would appear to have been inadvertently overlooked at Nairobi, and he would venture to tend to the expense for the inconvenience occasioned.

A. DIRECTORATE OF COMMUNICATIONS ORGANISATION OF TRAFFIC LINES SCHEME BY MR. RUSHTON

Possible Saving of £60,000 a Year
in Expenditure

POTENTIAL POSSIBILITIES OF KILINDINI

recent session of the Convention of Associations was given the opportunity of considering and voting on which, if carried into effect, would have vast importance to the interests of British East Africa.

H. Rushton, Acting Chief of the Uganda Railway, has now submitted a scheme for re-organisation of the communication system, and he was asked to present it to the Convention. The H.E. the Governor and the Manager of the Uganda Railway have obtained Mr. Rushton's scheme in part at the meeting of the Convention.

Introductory remarks by Mr. Conway, the Secretary (Mr. G. S. M. S.) and the scheme, which is for the re-organisation and management of the communications of the H.E.A., by combining in one, i.e., a Directorate of Communications, the following departments:

Works and Telegraphs.
Marine.

functions of these Departments the local market for the same classes of vehicles, etc. independent.

There are, like a small number from the amalgamation of small high ranking lines, the result of which is that some were under amalgamation and others not. In the former case, the intention is to make economies in administrative expenses.

Amalgamation, which will be a consequence of the proposed scheme, will be carried out in accordance with the principles designed to

their share and so qualify for promotion.

In assessing the scheme, shown in the statement, I am attached to the appointments under the Directorate. I have been guided to a considerable extent by the proposals of the Civil Service Commission, but I have taken into account the increase or reduction in duties and responsibilities which the re-organisation under a Directorate would involve.

1. The adoption of the proposed scheme would ensure the saving in time and money to be obtained thereby. I estimate at a minimum value of £30,000 per annum.

2. The scheme contemplates the housing, in due course, of all the Divisions of the Directorate in one building at Nairobi, with one combined District Office at Mombasa and at Kisumu, also at other places if found desirable. This would facilitate the establishment of a Central Registry, Correspondence and Typing Office in each place and the placing of all the staff of work and of all the necessary work. The amalgamation would also provide the necessary pooling of work and stores, works, purchases, purchases.

Highly trained technical officers such as mechanical and civil engineers, marines and traffic officers, would be relieved of the storehouse, accounting work, correspondence, etc., which at present wastes so much of their time and clogs their efforts; every European would be engaged upon work for which he had been specially trained and could effectively perform.

3. The scheme also contemplates and provides for the development of mechanical transport for passengers and provides the main materials from outlying districts to the Railways, a project which effects sound revenue earning prospects as a Government undertaking.

Under a Directorate such a master as the provision of a service of fast light trains carrying only first class passengers and mail and doing the journeys between Mombasa and Nairobi, and the Lake and Nairobi, during the night would receive prompt consideration as would also a service of fast motor-cars (such as are used at Home) between Nakuru and Nairobi and Thika and Nairobi; and a fast service of boats on the Lake; all are practicable and would undoubtedly prove financially successful.

4. Practically the same sum as that involved in the proposals of the Civil Service Commission for the separation of the establishment of various separate Divisions under reference would suffice to meet much higher salaries for men of the greatest importance under the Directorate and no less than £100 per month for good men. I attach a comparative statement showing this. In the statement I have not included officers below the rank of District Officers except in cases in which it is necessary to do so in order to indicate a change in organisation.

Re-arrangement.

Considerable rearrangement of staff officers would be necessary; in the Directorate they would require to be separated and others they would be reduced. The overall staff would, however, be a reduction on what is necessary under the system of separate Departments.

I have estimated deputation and influenced the District Officers, because I consider it is more appropriate that branch should have the best of their posts as permanent assistants and should, when going on leave, be able to obtain from two or more District Offices the most efficient to act for them, based on their experience to nominate their deputies.

Procedure at Headquarters would be similar to that at District offices.

The Secretary General would have charge of all staff records and deal with all staff questions.

There would be become complete file of correspondence on any subject the Directorate Office and District Officers readily available to all offices, and intra-departmental correspondence would not be necessary.

The chief working of a Central Registry entirely organised to meet the particular requirements could be explained verbally.

Centralized Traffic Record.

General and his Heads of Divisions. Executive matters would still be dealt with by the Director General and his Heads of Divisions.

Whether the position of the full Board in regard to the Government would be merely advisory or otherwise would be a matter for the Government to determine.

As regards the estimated minimum saving in time and money of £30,000 mentioned above, I would point out that the expenditure pro

vided in the Estimates for the Directorate, as presented, is £120,000 less, amounting to £70,000 for salaries and £50,000 for Extraordinary Expenses, and that a saving of £30,000 represents only a little over 40 per cent thereof.

I believe we have done little to promote our own work and also made it to some extent a burden. I have estimated the maximum saving at £50,000 per annum, and that it would be possible to have a more active and detailed re-organisation than that herein contemplated.

Explanatory:

At the request of the Chairman, Mr. Rushton made a few observations in the course of which he said:

"That which has been said as part and parcel of the scheme to be in a fully detailed nature, it is a mere summary of the main points of the scheme. The work set out therefrom would occupy some little time but the main object of my talk would be to explain why I think such a scheme would be of great benefit to you, particularly in view of the fact that the cost of running the Railways would be very considerably reduced, and saving a large amount of money.

"The Director General would be responsible for the

I have indicated, paving the way to greater prosperity than agriculture and stock raising alone could possibly produce. My memo which has been read is merely an attempt to point the means where by communications may best be developed in this end.

All we very aptly put it, we cannot always expect to win, but we can always set our names down in history as having tried. This excellent attitude will be all the better for our reputation as a nation of "Puritans" that is kept in mind.

There is no doubt that we have done a good cause for supporting the Olympic Games, which some Englishmen are in favour of dropping. There is no doubt that we are seeking to support a project for reviving them so as to make the British Empire should stand up to the rest of the world. It is the opinion of the writer, but 1920 seems much too soon. We have had a year to recover from the war and three years hence would appear to be quite early enough for the revival. That the English public will take a hand in this and that would seem to be about the earliest to meet with real success.

The British sporting spirit is a good one and it is this which makes the average English cricketer object to the "bowling" in Australian cricket and the "voicing" in American baseball.

Likewise, the Englishman's fondness for betting, depending largely on the running path, or in the case of a street fight hitting a billy goat, the bold kicking him or hitting him with a stick, is not to be envied and not playing the game.

Not that the Englishmen are not capable of the Radical trick at times. Unfortunately, however, that in certain parts of Lancashire it is accepted as quite the thing to drop (kick) a person in a fight.
