Serious Fighting Certain in India.

Assassination of British Official.

The Frontier Trouble.

May 4.—At Cairo it is reported that Col. Scott Moncrieff, Deputy Inspector of the Blue Nile Province, has been assassinated near Misalimic.

May 4.—The Governor has started with a force to investigate.

May 4.—In consequence of the reactivity of the Mohmads General Willcocks is proceeding to take command of the Khaiber. They are already smiting Landi Kotal.

May 5.—Thirteen to twenty thousand Afghans have crossed the border, the bulk of them in the direction of Landi Kotal. They attacked a blockhouse in that vicinity on Saturday night but were repulsed. General Willcocks arrived at Landi Kotal with a brigade and another is en route.

A local Sheikh murdered Colonel Scott Moncrieff and proclaimed himself a Prophet. He collected about 150 ex-dervishes and attacked a force under Governor Dickinson proceeding to restore order. They were beaten off losing 35 killed. Two Egyptian Officers were killed; Governor Dickinson and Major Logan wounded.

The Afghans it is said are the same wild undisciplined bands that appeared at the beginning of the Zakkahel trouble and do not exceed 9,000 altogether. It is declared in high quarters that there is no ground for believing they are acting with the concurrence of the Ameer.

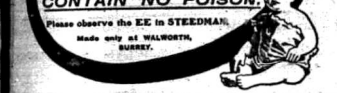

The Governor's Reply.

His Excellency in replying at the Labour Meeting held at Mombasa last week, a report of which appears elsewhere, agreed that many of the suggestions put forward by various speakers were very interesting but very difficult to carry out. We think that it would be found in actual practice the difficulties lie chiefly in the anticipation thereof rather than in their practical application. All great reforms appear astoundingly difficult to carry out until the reformers sit down determined to see them through, and what seemed almost impossible becomes possible and the mist easily penetrated.

To institute any reform, however, needs continuous application, courage and initiative.

His Excellency no doubt has good reason to see difficulty in taxing the Masai but we do not see those reasons and are of the opinion that half-a-dozen Settlers of the right stamp, with empty guns, could collect in a fortnight all those dues which rightfully belong to the State; we however do see a difficulty in collecting

taxes from each and every taxpayer of this country. His Excellency has asked for a larger Civil Administration Staff and we understand the request has not received that support from the Home Government which it deserves, possibly now that the Governor has the unanimous support of Mombasa in regard to the necessity for the re-organisation of Native Affairs including the collection of native revenue the Home Government will be more inclined to listen.

We cannot look upon the collection of £26,700 hut-tax in the Kenya Province in the same favourable light as His Excellency, as we consider the sum is trifling when we compare the enormous expense we annually incur on our Military, Police forces and Provincial Administration. Eight years ago it is true we collected no revenue from the Kenya Province (containing about one million inhabitants) but at this period we had not established control nor did we incur the annual expenditure which now plays such a large part in our Estimates.

We do not understand the policy of our Home or Local Government on the subject of Imported Indentured Labour. It is apparent that if there is to be any need for indentured labour it is right now. Mr. Anderson struck the right note when he referred to temporary imported labour. All who wish this country well hope that in the future when a Native Affairs Department has been established on broad lines imported indentured coolies will be no longer necessary—excepting perhaps for purely mechanical labour, a class of work which our local natives will not be able to undertake for half a century.

What then is to be gained by delay? The Government, it states, has determined to give the new system a fair trial, knowing at the same time that the Administrative Department of the Service has proved to be insufficiently staffed to carry on its present duties satisfactorily.

His Excellency has referred to the natives looking upon the District Commissioners as their fathers and is of the opinion that they are the best labour officers as they are constantly in touch with the people. Such visits as we have made to various Districts do not allow us to hold this view. In the first instance we know of Districts in which, from leave period to leave period, District Commissioners have not stirred beyond a day's journey from their station buildings and if the Government would test the assertion, it is merely necessary to inquire how it was possible for such a collection of murderers and thieves to have gathered together at Mtongwe unknown to the District Officials, as evidenced in the case of the foul murder of the late Mr. London.

Secondly our natives have quite failed to understand the intricacies of the Indian Procedure Codes and do not recognise that the blunders and injustices committed are not the fault of the unfortunately placed District Commissioner but the system.

There cannot be any reasonable doubt that the solution of the Labour Question and proper Administration of Native Affairs lies not in our present system, but in the establishment of a new Department and incidentally in strengthening the Executive Council of this Protectorate.

Our Governing Powers.

Above we have referred to the strengthening of our Executive Council. At present our Executive Councilors, that is to say our Cabinet Ministers who under the guidance of the Governor determine our policy, consist of the Lieut.

Sleeping Sickness.

Powerful Appeal by H. E. Hesketh Bell.

TO THE EDITOR OF THE STANDARD.

Sir.—In the hope of attracting the great and sympathetic aid of your readers towards the unfortunate victims of sleeping sickness in Uganda, I venture to address you.

A short time ago I had an opportunity of visiting the refuge for sufferers from sleeping sickness, which is maintained at Kisumu, not far from Kampala, by the African Mission. Even at the time when the disease had been considered to be of such an infectious nature that its victims were assumed like the plague-stricken, those exemplary missionaries had, finally, collected large numbers of the sufferers, and, in spite of the apparent futility of all curative measures, had devoted themselves to alleviating the pains and miseries of the doomed. The sick who, in many cases, had been thrown out by their terrified relatives to starve in the jungle, or to be devoured by wild beasts, were rescued, fed, and nursed without reference to creed or character.

Almost entirely without extraneous assistance the worthy Fathers, during the past five years, have maintained an average of a hundred unfortunate creatures in their stable and the record of over 500 burials in their crowded cemetery testifies to the inefficiency of the various curative measures which, from time to time, have been recommended and tried. This work of mercy has, of course, been but a drop in the ocean of misery that has afflicted the unfortunate population of Uganda during the last few years, but it is nevertheless none the less meritorious and deserving of recognition.

At the time of my visit to the refuge the inmates numbered 110. They were lodged in large thatched bandas and were divided according to sex and the various stages of the disease. In one enclosure we saw a number of infants, in whom the first outward signs of the scourge were just appearing. Unaware of their impending doom, the little black mites played and romped to their hearts' content in the shade of the banana grove, and only the swollen glands at the base of their necks showed that their fate was sealed. It was sad indeed to think that in a very short time, those merry peals of laughter would gradually become more and more rare, and that all these poor little creatures, in whom the joy of life was so strong, would, after a year or two of misery, be laid in the crowded cemetery that I could just see between the trees.

In a row of sheds, surrounded by the banana groves which supply the food for the patients, we saw numbers of those who had reached the second stage of the disease. Most of them appeared to be suffering acutely. They seemed to shun the hot shade of the broad thatched roofs, and to prefer to sit in the full blaze of the noon day sun. Even there many of them shivered almost constantly, and drew about their emaciated limbs the brown rags of the moon day sun. Many merely groaned. The drawn features and haggard eyes testified to the gnawing pains that almost constantly afflict them, and the unhappy creatures seemed to have special dread of being touched. Many of them were in the peculiar state of lethargy which has, doubtless, been responsible for the misleading name by which this disease has become commonly known. Unfortunately, sound sleep rarely comes to the relief of the doomed ones, and the torpor in which they lie comes from the constant strain of nerve-creating pain. Many of them, in an unguarded moment, put an end to their miserable lives, and it is a wonder that more of them do not do likewise.

Further on, we came to those who were in the last stages of the disease. Lying about on beds of withered leaves, they had reached a degree of emaciation that was horrible to see. The unhappy creatures looked like skeletons, and only their doleful moaning indicated the presence of life in the wretched remains. A few, in whom nature was struggling hard and going bravely on, and in spite of the fact that the poor creatures had perforce to be chained to heavy logs to prevent their doing harm, are almost saved; their remaining time of existence that afflicted their fellow-victims. The frenzied laughter of these unfortunate seemed particularly dreadful in that abode of suffering and death.

On our way back to the lines of huts occupied by those in the second stage of the disease, I asked the good Bishop, who is in charge of the mission, where he might do give pleasure in the way to the unhappy inmates of the stable. He replied that an inordinate craving for food was one of the signs of sleeping sickness. "You will realize," he said, "that with the very slender resources at our disposal, we can do no more than feed those poor creatures in the simplest and their entire food, and these are grown in the large groves which you see around the mission. An intense desire for meat or for any fatty substance is one of the characteristic symptoms of the disease, and it is not unusual for a native, who has contracted sleeping sickness, to recklessly kill and eat all his sheep and goats, and in a very short space of time the Bishop had barely finished announcing to the unfortunate people that a bullock would be killed and cooked for them that night than they were met by excited and wild with intense joy. Those who were still

capable of vigorous movement jumped about with delight; others threw themselves on the grass in gratitude; and even on the faces of the most pathetic and in some cases of advanced intellect, their sufferings ceased for the moment to be forgotten, and one could only regret that the alleviation was to be of such a fleeting nature.

A project for dealing with sleeping sickness in Uganda has recently received the approval of the Secretary of State for the Colonies, and it is hoped that the Government will shortly afford the means of the measure may be carried.

It is generally accepted that a variety of the human fly, the *Glossina Palpalis*, is the principal, if not the only, agent for the transmission of the disease. This fly exists in enormous numbers in the swamps of the Victoria Nyansa, and also on the borders of some other lakes and rivers of Uganda. Its habits, however, is restricted to a narrow belt of forest growth adjoining water, and within of two miles is believed to be the limit of the infested zones. Scientists appear to be generally agreed in believing that the insects fly only a few miles, and consequently comparatively short periods after feeding on a diseased person, and something under 48 hours is considered to be the limit. Under the conditions which have hitherto prevailed, the disease has raged uninterruptedly through the population inhabiting the fly-infested belt, and the insect has constantly found at hand a number of fresh infections. Out of some 300,000 souls inhabiting the shores of Victoria Nyansa and the islands in the great lake, over 500,000 have already been swept out of existence, and it remains to be seen whether the remainder can still be saved.

The extermination of the insect appears to be a hopeless task, and it has, therefore, been decided to remove all the surviving population out of the reach of the fatal fly. All those who still appear to be healthy are being located on fly-free areas inland, while the sick are placed in concentration camps, also in uninfected districts, where they will be cared for as well as means will permit, and where they may receive such modified treatment as gives promise of successful results. Axioly and other drugs which, so far, appear to alleviate suffering, are being regularly administered. Even though all attempts to cure those already affected may result in failure, it is hoped that, by completely removing from the insect the possibility of re-infecting them, the insects may gradually become as innocuous as they appear to have been prior to the introduction of the disease into the country.

It is estimated that over 10,000 sick remain to be dealt with, and they are being located in large camps capable of accommodating about 1,000 at a time. Through the Lords of the Imperial Treasury, upon whom the administration of Uganda still has to depend to a certain extent, have authorized the expenditure of a considerable sum of money in measures now proposed, everything has to be done on the most economical scale. Most of the unfortunate inmates of the camps are very poor persons, and those who have neither friends nor relatives get nothing but a modicum of bananas and beans. Their immediate relief for meat will have to be unobtainable, and the misery of their remaining days will have few alleviations. A hint of food or mutation now and then would, to these poor creatures, be an intense joy, and it is in the hope of obtaining some form of their means of procuring this for the afflicted ones that I venture to enlist your powerful aid.

Cattle, sheep, and goats are cheap in Uganda, and a comparatively moderate sum would enable us to provide now and then a meal of meat for the unhappy inmates of the sleeping sickness camps. Unless a cure be soon discovered they will not long remain a charge to us, and if your readers could see the intense delight that manifested the faces of the inmates of the refuge at Kisumu at the prospect of meat they would think a few shillings well spent in that direction.

WORLD'S NEWS BY CABLE.

Affairs in Morocco.

Refusal to receive Envoys in Paris.

May 16.—General Vigy's column on the Southern Algerian border had who were driven back and took up a new position which Vigy attacked on Thursday but no mention is made of the result.

May 16.—Another party of Mula Hadid envoys are in Paris and called on the Foreign office but the officials declined to receive them.

The Enemy's Severe Loss.

May 19.—The French occupied Bodein after a seven hours' attack on Friday and the enemy was routed with heavy loss abandoning their supplies. The French casualties were slight.

May 19.—Generals Lyautey and Bledin are proceeding to Tunis. The former has been appointed High Commissioner of the Frontier.

May 19.—General Damade telegraphs that three were killed and 22 wounded in the engagement in the Cas Blancs, Hinterland.

May 16.—At Casa Blanca a brawl took place between French and Spanish soldiers and five Spaniards being killed and two Frenchmen wounded.

May 15.—A later telegram states that the fight was only among native policemen lately introduced and no Europeans were involved.

Municipal Elections in France

May 18.—In France the final municipal elections show that the Republicans have gained a majority in 1064 councils.

The Indian Frontier The Munster Regiment Suffering Loss by Cholera.

May 19.—Twenty seven men of the Munster Regiment which were originally attached to the Mohmand expedition have died of Cholera. The Mohmands made a determined night attack on the pickets at Derwazak and left many dead. The 2nd Punjab was heavily pressed for hours and lost 9 killed and 24 wounded.

Health of Troops Improving.

May 20.—Barrett's Brigade has advanced up the Boteboia valley severely opposed by the Mohmands. There were 30 casualties. The health of the troops is good and the cholera has abated.

Hard Fighting.

A Big Task. May 21.—Barrett's Brigade fought 2,000 of the enemy led by an Afghan near Zunawar clearing strongly held hills and the sides of the valley. Sixty of the enemy were killed and the British casualties amount to 33 including 3 officers wounded one of whom dangerously.

The Mansion House Meeting.

May 18.—At a meeting held in the Mansion House presided over by the Lord Mayor it was decided to open a National Fund to present Canada, with a birthday gift in memory of Wolf and Montcalm.

Trouble in India.

May 18.—In Calcutta a bomb exploded on the Train Line destroyed a cart and injured four people. It has been ascertained that pamphlets have been circulating warning natives not to ride in 1st Class cars.

Licensing Bill.

Speech by the Bishop of London.

May 18.—At a Licensing demonstration held in the Albert Hall on Saturday, the Bishop of London who presided said that he believed the Church should not be tied to any party but should stand or fall with any Government dealing with a national disaster such as drink. Any Government trying to remedy the evil took its life in its hand.

Honour for the late Premier.

May 19.—Mr. Morley's motion that a monument to the late Sir Henry Campbell Bannerman be erected in Westminster Abbey was unanimously adopted after short and sympathetic speeches by Mr. Asquith and Mr. Balfour.

May 18.—An admiralty order has been issued which suspends night attacks and exercises till further notice. On Saturday, meetings of the ship-workers on the Tyne and Tees resolved to reject the proposed terms of settlement.

America's President.

May 18.—There are indications that generally the Republican Convention is inclined to nominate Taft for the Presidency on the first ballot.

The Gala Disaster.

May 18.—The Court martial on the disaster to the "Gala" reprimanded the Commander for losing his ship by default and dismissed the charge of negligence.

Commercial Treaty Between France and England.

May 18.—Britain and France are utilizing the presence of M. Cruppe in London to informally discuss the question of the conclusion of a Commercial Treaty.

The King Visits the Tsar.

May 21.—The "Times" announces that The King will pay a visit to the Tsar, starting on the 5th June and returning home on the 12th.

May 21.—Reuters learns that the meeting of the Tsar and King occurs at Revel and the King arrives there on 9th June escorted by two ministers.

Turkey Querulous.

May 21.—The Porte is sending Circular to the Powers expressing its apprehension at the withdrawal of the International Troops from Crete and pointing out that serious consequences may result.

The Government will Improve the Electorate Position.

WOMENS RIGHTS.

May 21.—Mr. Asquith replying to a suffragist deputation said that before the close of the present Parliament Government would pass a comprehensive measure of Electoral Reform. He himself did not advocate Womens Suffrage but Government would not opposed amendment to its Bill in favour thereof.

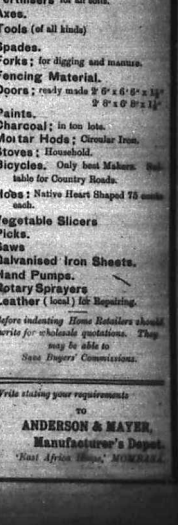
