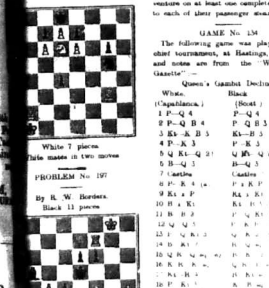

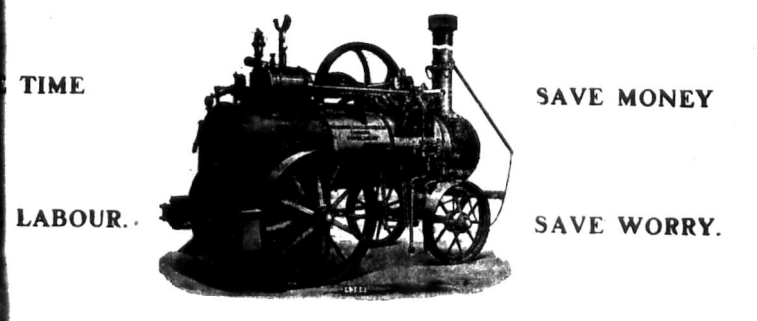

SHOP HOURS BILL.

Objects of the Bill. To regulate the hours of business of shops in the City of Nairobi.

Section 1. In this Bill, the expression "shop" means any building, or any part of a building, in which goods are sold or offered for sale, and includes any stall, counter, or booth, but does not include a public house or a place where any game is played.

Section 2. The hours of business of a shop shall be regulated by the Nairobi Corporation, subject to the approval of the Nairobi Municipal Council.

Section 3. The Nairobi Corporation may, by notice in writing, require any shop to be closed during such hours as may be specified in the notice.

Section 4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Bill shall be liable to a fine not exceeding five pounds.

Section 5. This Bill shall come into force on such date as may be appointed by the Nairobi Corporation.
