Coincident with the arrival in the source of a second dog the children were once again attacked and continued to be attacked at intervals until the dog was sent away, six months fter its arrival.

after its arrival.

The Parents at this stage began to connect the occurrence of the illness in some way with the keeping of dogs and decided to keep the children away from these animals as much as possible. After a period of about eighteen months a Caller at the house happened to be accom-panied by a dog and although the animal was less than an hour on the premises two days after its visit two old illness. On the patients' bodies several flea bites were noticed.

The next occasion when the illness broke out was when two of the children were visiting a healthy highland station, here as it happen-ed dogs were kept. Both children were attacked, the one two days pefore the other, and both had been bitten by fleas; some of these insects were observed on their clothing.

The most recent case, which has caused the publication of this article, occurred when a dog—recently arrived from upcountry where it had been running in com-pany with another dog since dead from tick fever—visited the house. The day afterwards one of the children (aged four) was severely bitten by fleas presumably from the visiting dog as no fleas had previously been noticed about the house. The child is now recovering after 48 ours of the usual illness.

It would be most interesting to the Europeans living in this country if some of our Government Doctors would publish their opinions as to whether or no the Parents are correct in holding that there is a spe-

If the Parents are correct it would be as well for lay folk to know whether this disease is communicated by fleas from does or other label works office-bodders are people desired. animals and if so what animals in ddition to dogs should be avoided.

Pending some authoritative deci-sion on this point we would earnestly advise the mothers of children to avoid the domestic dog as they would a plague infected rat.

#### Official Brokers.
