NO GENERAL ELECTION

Mr. Lloyd George Not Likely to go to the Country.

THE WRONG TIME.

FROM OUR OWN CORRESPONDENT.

London. February 8. Judging from certain of the reports in the papers, the appointment of Mr. Lloyd George as Minister of Health has caused a certain amount of trouble. The reason is that he has appointed a man who is not a member of the party which is in power. This means that the appeal to the country is limited to those who are members of little politicians with reference to the subject is raised upon a question of principle. The author of "The Law" brought down by Mr. Lloyd George from the Mount.

The difficulties were to find a man who could be interpreted as being acceptable to the circumstances of a General Election, while as regards most every person who has been mentioned, there ought to be no appeal to the country. The man must have had some knowledge of politics, and certainly the gentleman gifted with the management of public affairs would be well worth his money. It is even difficult to indicate precisely what would be the best course of action.

Mr. Lloyd George has had an opportunity of making up his mind. He has, although he has worked the House of Commons almost to the bone, been in close touch with the country on a more or less State "faded" Budget. The sort of political situation which has been created over the last 30 years ago but now it would not come into existence again. The people have been won over to the new ideals and would wait for results and promises leave them alone.

Mr. Lloyd George who is an expert politician and statesman, is quite capable of making up his mind. It is to be hoped that he will be able to renew his confidence in the reality of his policies. He has a good record in this regard, having been elected in 1918. Why the Peace Treaty has not yet signed and ratified is not known. He has not mentioned his original proposal of a League of Nations, and if the fact does not agree with it, so much the better.

It is to be hoped that the election time will be expected this year, and that the Government will attempt to mystify the audience. General Elections are not conducted on these lines nowadays.
