In ploughing the garden, have as far as possible open spaces between your hedges, planting groups of trees on either side, if space permits; plant shrubs in groups, and as far as possible to form blocks of colour, so that the garden may look like a picture; if the colour scheme is rather limited, plant formal hedges in open spaces, or where large trees are, a pergola leading from one part of the garden; a corner has the effect of magnifying plants.

## ALTERNATIVE SCHEME

If the garden is to be planted in a line, the best plan is to have the most effective with cool rectangular blocks of grass, stepped heights and straight paths, and the paths should be of course, if the house allows it.

The house is very small and gives little shade, so plant trees, covering your verandah with roses, mandevilla, potato creeper, and lantana, and plant a few wall irregular groups of flowers, curving borders, and low down, trailing plants.

Riding ground away from the houses must be planted with trees to obtain shade, and the garden view must be carefully made the most of, especially in a town or suburb garden.

Don't be afraid to plant.
