A Scour in a Sand-Cart.

To those who take pleasure in the study of the records of the great past a journey from Cairo to Sakkara, and thence across the desert to Ghizeh, is replete with absorbing interest. Near this great memorial mausoleum in the Tomb of the Bulls, perhaps the most extraordinary burial of enormous sculptured groups throughout in which the numerous sacred bulls are interred. Again climbing up into the sand-cart he continues his journey across the interminable sand of the Libyan Desert. But who is to the traveller if a sand-storm arises, especially if he is in a sand-cart, for whatever precautions be taken every morsel of food will be gritty and unobtainable.

At length, his journey nearly ended, the traveller rises awhile under the shade of the Great Pyramid, that mighty glory of all the structures ever erected on this earth. Ah, those Egyptian old, were a great race. Yet notwithstanding their virile powers and their masterly abilities, they believed that those pampered bulls, whose bodies they so reverently interred, could both control their destiny in this life, and adjust their fate in the life to come. Happily we, instead of addressing our petitions to a man, can with confidence approach the Creator of the universe. For by suffering death upon the cross on our behalf and as redemption, for our sins the Son of God has engaged from the record of the Account every entry made against those who come to Him for eternal life.

SIR HESKETH BELL ON COTTON AND UGANDA.

"NEW MARKETS FOR WHOSE BENEFIT?"

At Liverpool prior to the departure for West Africa, Sir Henry Heskestad, the Chief of Northern Nigeria, was entertained at luncheon by the late Sir Alfred Jones, President of the Liverpool Chamber of Commerce, and gentlemen associated with West Africa trade.

Mr. Hesketh Bell, in replying to a toast, said:—The kindness of your welcome suggests to me the happy thought that in the future, trust, always exist between the merchant provinces of Liverpool and the administrative provinces of West Africa.

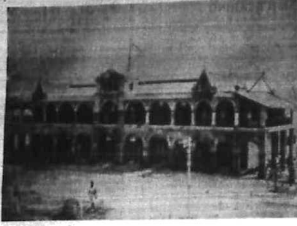

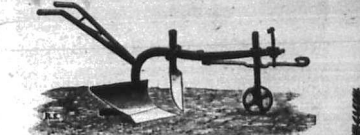

The Elections.

Lord Lansdowne Speaking at Liverpool.

Jan. 7.—Lord Lansdowne speaking at Liverpool complained of the vagueness of Ministers allusions to the future of the House of Lords he himself advocates reforms on the lines of Lord Rosebery's Committee's Report, that he is opposed to wider reforms as he believes in the pre-ponderating power of the House of Commons and that if the House of Lords was founded on an elective basis they would soon claim what they do not claim now, namely, Coordinate Power with the House of Commons.

Rowdy Meeting.

Jan. 10.—On Saturday night amid noisy scenes the Duke of Norfolk addressing a meeting at Brighton the most rowdy chaff was exchanged and the Duke offered to sign his name to any interruptions if they would not listen to his speech.

Mr. Lloyd-George's Promises.

Jan. 10.—Mr. Lloyd-George speaking at Plymouth stated that the Government intended to raise enormous sums of money for the defence of the country, that they provided nearly £3,000,000 more in last year for the Navy and in the next Budget they would raise £20,000,000 without burdening the people.
