



ANNUAL REPORT FOR LAST YEAR.

Below is the President's Report presented to the Annual General Meeting of the Y.W.C.A. held in Nairobi last month.

During the year delegations were received from Mr. Harry Barry on behalf of the YMCA, Mr. John Sibley, Mr. G. M. Morris (leaving for Trinidad), Mrs. Miles (domestic servant) Mandeville, Mr. Lovell and Mr. Lovell kindly consented to fill the vacancies.

Officers were elected at the first Meeting of the Board and Sub-Committees, Hostel, Social and Tennis were all appointed.

It is recommended that at the next Meeting, that in future Officers should be elected at the Annual Meeting instead of at the Board, so that the Members of the Association may exercise their right of choice.

The Hostel, Social and Tennis Committees and the Board and the Board of Directors met on Tuesday and the Board of Directors on the second Tuesday of each month.

Annual Meetings of the Executive and Building Committees have also been held during the year.

In April, Lady Northey, our Patroness left England for Kenya with much regret. We trust that she will regain her actions illness, and they desire to express to her their hearty congratulations on her removal to the land of Kenya.

The Committee receives with regret the resignations of Miss Maywood, the Hon. Member for Kynsna.

The Association Membership is now 122 new Members were elected during the year.

The Members' Subscriptions amounted to £1,000/0/- which 20 have been sent to Subscribers to the World's Y.W.C.A.

Certain pamphlets have been obtained from Headquarters, and have been forwarded to up-country members as the only means of keeping them sympathetic and touch with the work.




