THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

The Native Reserve Roads Bill.

We give some extracts from the Bill to be introduced at the next sitting of the Legislative Council providing for roads in the Native Reserves.

Clause 3.—It shall be lawful for the Governor to order a Chief, Council of Elders, or a Headman to mark and maintain in such manner as he may think necessary the boundaries of the area over which the Chief, Council of Elders, or Headman exercises jurisdiction.

Clause 4.—It shall be lawful for the Governor to order that a road shall be made by or on behalf of a Native Reserve by the Chief, Council of Elders, or Headman of the respective areas of places through or by which such road is intended, to run or to be kept in a state of repair by the Chief, Council of Elders, or Headman of the respective areas of places.

Clause 5.—Any Chief, Council of Elders or Headman who contravenes the provisions of the Governor as aforesaid, to mark or maintain the boundaries of the area or to perform any of the duties specified in the Governor in such order and who shall be liable to be fined not more than £100, or to be imprisoned not more than three months.

Prevention of Spread of Insect Pests Bill.

Clause 2.—It shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time to make regulations for the prevention of the spread of insect pests in any of the following purposes—

(a) for preventing the introduction of any insect pest or other pest into any place in which such pest is not known to exist;

(b) for the forwarding and inspecting of goods in which plants are contained, and for the forwarding and inspecting of any other material of importation;

(c) for the carrying of fire in any place in which such fire is not known to exist, or for the carrying of any other material of importation.

Provided that no penalty shall be imposed by any such regulation as aforesaid except in the case of a person who is guilty of an offence under this Ordinance for a term not exceeding three months.

Clause 3.—It is the duty of the Governor to issue orders in writing in the following cases—

(a) when he is satisfied that any person has committed an offence under this Ordinance;

(b) when he is satisfied that any person is guilty of an offence under this Ordinance;

(c) when he is satisfied that any person is guilty of an offence under this Ordinance.

Clause 3.—It shall be lawful for the Governor to order the Director of Agriculture to examine any maize intended to be exported from the Protectorate to be used for such purpose as he may think fit, and to require the exporter to produce and exhibit the same at such place or places as the Director may think fit.

Clause 4.—Wherever the Director of Agriculture shall have jurisdiction, whether by a general or special notification, any Officer appointed by or on behalf of the Director of Agriculture for the purpose of examining any maize intended to be exported from the Protectorate shall be permitted to be accompanied by a representative of the Protectorate by the Director of Agriculture.

Clause 5.—If upon the examination of any maize intended to be exported from the Protectorate the Director of Agriculture shall find such maize or any part thereof to be in a defective condition, or to be of a quality inferior to that specified in the notification, he may prohibit the exportation of such maize, or may require the exporter to take such steps as he may think fit to be taken for the purpose of remedying the defect.

Limitations to the Debates in the Commons.

ASQUITH DECLINES TO SHOW HIS HANDS.

LONDON, April 1. In the House of Commons Mr. Asquith said he hoped that the debate on his resolutions would be closed next Monday and a motion will be submitted on Tuesday limiting the time for discussion of the Budget. Resolutions will be allowed a week in committee.

These announcements are generally interpreted as indicating Mr. Asquith's intention to hasten the issue that the Nationalists will not oppose the Budget and that there will be an Election early in May.

There are indications that the Crown is likely to be the subject of a "Polemics." The "Daily Telegraph" denounces Churchill's criminal recklessness for dragging the Crown into the present controversy and states that it is Mr. Asquith's duty to repudiate Mr. Lieutenants' opinions and perhaps wild words.

The House of Commons have adopted a motion to censure the Veto Resolution by 217 votes to 133. According to the programme announced by Asquith the Veto resolutions will be passed by the 14th instant, the Budget finished before the recess at the end of April.
