MISS MOLLY ELLIS.

Arrives at Home with Her Father.

NO PUBLIC STATEMENT.

Miss Molly Ellis, the English girl whose mother was murdered on the North-West Frontier of India, and who was herself held captive by hillmen for four days and three nights, has arrived at home accompanied by her father, Major Ellis. Passengers on the "Gulliford" by which Major and Miss Ellis travelled said that throughout the voyage there had been throughout the Major and his daughter that a sense of thoughtful consideration and sympathy which they recalled.

In the interest of the health of Miss Ellis it was decided that she should be the recipient of the largest number of newspaper items from Plymouth, but the following statement was issued:—
"Major and Miss Molly Ellis have arrived. They had a good voyage and are both well. They are grateful for the kindly sympathy extended to them by their friends and neighbours and the public generally, and are confident that their desire, for the most modest rest and quietness of their home will be respected by everybody. They have no desire to make of public interest and cannot grant interviews to the Press."

India Boasting with Virens.

A well-known Indian traveller who travelled on the "Calcutta" said the outbreak which robbed Major Ellis of his wife and caused him anxiety for so many days concerning the safety of his daughter was entirely due to political causes.

"India," he said "is in a state of rest from end to end. The law-abiding who live on the frontier defend for the luxuries of life, and are not to be taken by surprise. In the case of the murder of Mrs. Ellis and the kidnapping of her daughter, the outbreak was not faked for the sake of ransom, but just to curtail the neighbourly tribes on the border. If the British power is not what it used to be...

"It was always the fear of the frontier tribes that whatever culture they committed would bring its own destruction. The old idea was that whatever happened at first, even if punitive parties failed owing to lack of strength, the British would return and the natives, paid off, would be left to their own devices. The Border tribes have increased in numbers, and have control on outposts which are no longer as they would never have contemplated."
