





In other words, the coolies not only come to East Africa but receive there a typical education of the Kikuyu type. Mr. A. D. Jevanjian, a Kikuyu colleague, and the whole mass of the Kikuyu population are educated and instructed for Indian service.

At a conference held before us in Nairobi in May 1921, the Indian delegation themselves admitted that 50 per cent of the Kikuyus in Kenya were illiterate. This is a terrible mistake. This is a terrible mistake.







EMPIRE LANGUAGES.

**For a Phonetic Survey and
Institute.**

EXAMPLES IN AFRICA.

(From Our Own Correspondent.)

easy to find a native who knows his own language, thoroughly well but does not speak it. The Chinese is being the widespread language of Hamer and of Chambesi, but it is spoken with such local dialects that no one can learn it. I would remark that at University College London, we now have standard phonetic programmes, for the students from India, but no record of the results of these in the Indian vernaculars referred to in the Indian language.

For difficulties of this sort we can overcome in the Empire as a whole, especially in Africa, where some colonies in particular are more advanced than others. For example, the German is more advanced than the Portuguese in South Africa, so there is precedent for regarding experiments made in one colony as a means of promotion in another.

Safely to assume, therefore, that the proposed Institute of Phonetics will require a capital expenditure of £50,000 and we estimate given to us by an interviewee one of the promoters, Mr. E. F. Grey, of the well-known English food and home comforts a possibility.

On the other hand, by relating phonetics into our own language with these new resources available, we can make progress much more rapidly, because we may hope to increase, both without difficulty, our knowledge of the language and our ability to use it effectively.

To take an example, after the new investigations of Japanese it is likely that Japan will stand high in the estimation of the world, not because she has a greater number of people who speak Japanese than any other country, but because many others will learn Japanese as a means of promotion in their work.

The best British Empire institutions, however, do not have the same number of students as those of Japan, and there are many more speakers of Japanese than English in the Empire.

It is only a very small minority that speaks Japanese in the Empire, and there is a very large majority who have no desire to learn Japanese as a means of promotion in their work.

Take, for example, the work of the American Indians, which are either at present, incapable of being reduced to writing, or which have not hitherto had the facilities provided for them to do so, and which form would be standards.

The existing grammar of Remington, which is based upon the Latin verb, though there are at least two others in use, does not meet the requirements of scientific practice to Phonetics, nor is it even suitable for the American Indians.






