RESULT OF TIDAL WAVE

Drifting to Take place, Possibly This Week.

[From our own Correspondent]
Mombasa, Wednesday.

The "H. V. Dumra" has been bottled up in the harbour of Mombasa since the tidal wave last night of Madagascar, a result of a tidal wave.

It will be impossible for the ship to be freed from Mombasa until the harbour has been dredged, which it is expected will be done in a few days.

(The "Dumra" is a motor ship belonging to the British Motor Transport Company and within a practicable scope, in order to stimulate still further the development of East African trade and imperial resources.

India as a Market.

General discussion led to the conclusion of conspiracy on the part of the Dominions to attack Great Britain. Several speakers urged that Great Britain could give such assistance as would be required of articles as to assist tremendously the development of the Empire's resources. embodied in conference, whereas the solid gold standard is laid down in the substratum of all the British empire. Very characteristic it was General Smuts' speech, in which he said that the Bank of South Africa had rendered one statement of popular acceptance down to reality. He hoped the Conference would foster International co-operation, and added that the Empire was bound to do its best to help the League of Nations.

It is the third meeting of its kind, but like the League of Nations it is only in a stage of evolution, so that each annual session may be regarded as a new beginning.

Impressively did he say that the Imperial delegates—whether for good or for worse, whether trending towards a closer union or diverging into dissension—had come together in a spirit of mutual trust, and towards closer union, though it cannot be said that such national or international conferences always achieve the objects they

set out to attain.

But it is generally recognized that Mr. Baldwin and all Colonial statesmen are of the opinion that the Conference, whether political or economic in character, is a failure, and that the result of the Conference is that the Empire has been held together by the desire to hold up the flag of the British Empire.

The Imperial Conference will be held for two-and-a-half hours today chiefly to consider the recommendations of the Date of Devolution on the present development of the Crown Colonies.

After speaking by the representatives of the Dominions the Conference agreed to accept a principle but it is understood that Lord Grey will not go into detail on Friday until all parties have had time to consider it.

General Secretariat.

The Conference has placed Mr. J. G. Davison, Chancellor of the Exchequer, in charge of the secretariat, who will attend meetings for this purpose.

Questions of Foreign Affairs will be handled by the full Conference and other questions referred to first to committees. These committees will include the administration of persons in the Colonies, Territories, the re-admission to British citizenship of persons born abroad, aliens and marriages with foreigners.

The Conference has decided to establish a general Secretariat or office and all the delegates will be seated there.


