## NORTHERN RHODESIA A PROTECTORATE.

### Outline of the New Constitution.

#### LEGISLATURE'S POWERS.

An Order in Council published on the 1st January, 1924, March 21 provides for the Government of Northern Rhodesia as a British Protectorate. The territory was taken over from the King of Loanda by the Imperial authorities on April 1, 1891, and on March 20, 1900.

Provision is made for a Governor, a Legislative Council and a Legislative Council. The Governor will possess powers similar to those of the Governor of a Colony or a Crown Colony. The Legislative Council will consist of five or six officers nominated by the Governor, one nominated member, and three elected members, who will be re-elected every three years. It will enact such ordinances as are necessary for the welfare of the public, the raising of revenue, etc., and may make laws for the promotion of agriculture and other productive work in the making and marketing of all kinds of produce.

The right of self-government will be given to Northern Rhodesia by the British Government to determine its own internal affairs. Civil and criminal jurisdiction to be exercised in conformity with the law of the land, and the Roman Dutch law, as on the 1st January, 1924.

Surrounding the Native. Special provision is made to safeguard the native population. The Order in Council says:

No conditional, disabilities, or restrictions shall be imposed which shall apply to persons of European descent, or to persons of African descent, or to persons of mixed race, but no person shall be imposed upon natives (save in respect of taxation) any disability, or restriction, or liability, by any Proclamation, Regulation or other instrument, which would render them incapable of performing their civil or political functions, or which shall have been so expressed, defined and limited in such manner.

It shall not be lawful for any act of Parliament to give power to the Chief and other officers of the British Government reserved from protection to the native population of Northern Rhodesia to be given to the native population of the Colony.


All contracts made by or for the benefit of the native population by the above-named officers of the British Government shall continue to be valid and have effect.

A native may hold, own, cultivate, and dispose of land on the same terms as any other person, not a native, but no native may encumber or alienate land or property which he holds, except under the contract is made in the name of the native, is signed by him, and is witnessed by two persons, and signed by him stating that the contract is made in accordance with his wishes, and is reasonable, and that he gave his consent thereto.

The appointment of Mr. Herbert H. H. Aspinwall, C.M.G., as Governor and Commandant-in-Chief of Northern Rhodesia, announced on March 19, 1924, is gazetted under date March 21, 1924.

AFFIRMATIVE REFERENCES  
BY AN OBSERVANT FRIEND

Prince Arthur of Connaught, late Governor-General and High Commissioner for South Africa, and the Prime Minister of the Union of South Africa, Sir Jan Smuts, on the night of March 26, Lord Buxton, the president, was in the chair.

Prince Arthur said his task during the last four years had been to make much easier by his presence the work of the members of the cabinet, to whom he had given full support. Lord Buxton, to whom he had been plucked from the south African service, referred to the loyalty, devotion and hard work of the members of the General Service and its Ministers during his tenure of office.

## Our Progress

Referring to his visit on the way down to East Africa, Prince Arthur said he was much struck by the progress made by the British in the taken place since he was there fifteen years ago. Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, and Southern Rhodesia were all over 50 million African people, were believed, and on the whole were healthy, and the white settlers were well educated and intelligent. The advance in education was particularly great in this group of countries. What was true of Kenya applied, for example, was this year 100,000 children were in school, 100,000 in houses. In return there were large numbers of British settlers. In general, though, the progress was slow, particularly in the north of Kenya, where at last recovering from the effects of the war, and still after the war, the bulk of the white settlers, mostly ex-Navy men, who had served their country deserved every assistance possible.

## "Welcoming Them In."

Speaking of the large number of persons who had come to him who proposed visiting the British East Africa, Prince Arthur remarked that the British Government had no objection to this country for entertainment visitors, who had always struck him as being most welcome. People landed in London full of enthusiasm, but when they came here a week later they enthusiasm had gone. This was not entirely due to the heat, but it was due to the climate. It was also due to the cold manner of the British. He hoped that when he left his home that the average Englishman would be a good deal more considerate of visitors, and hold out the hand of friendship and welcome. He hoped that the British Empire would be a land of opportunity for all who came there, that apportioned to the welfare of the British Empire. (Cheers.)


