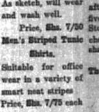

A FUTURE FOR KENYA WHEAT.

Results of Experiments by the Dept. of Agriculture.

PRODUCTION OF RUST-RESISTING VARIETIES.

The Possibility of Capturing the South African Market.

The following is a resume of the results of the experiments conducted by the Agricultural Department of Kenya since the beginning of 1924:

It is shown that Kenya has always suffered severely from rust, a disease which can only be combated by breeding "rust-resistant" varieties, and after many wheat crops had been destroyed by this fungus it became imperative to wheat breeders to study the results of the Agricultural Department.

The first appointment was that of Mr. C. W. Jones in 1920. He imported and tested hundreds of wheat strains of various provenances and the most promising strains were put on to this day. Mr. Jones had the service in 1922 and it became necessary to appoint a South African wheat breeder, being appointed early in 1921.

The situation here found was as follows:—(1) Presently all the varieties of wheat growing in the country were raised and sown in factories in quality; (2) Wheat crops all over the Colony were being destroyed by rust; (3) The wheat crops were being raised on the Black Sea and 2000 acres were being sown from the black steen rust and the yellow rust.

The following steps were taken to build this state of wheat:
