NEW GOVERNMENT'S WAY

Under South African supervision our Union Parliament met on Friday last at Cape Town, with the new Post Government occupying the chair on being held by General Smuts and his colleagues.

The Governor-General's speech was a comparatively short one, and dealt chiefly with the present pressing problem of European unemployment. There was no reference in the speech to Asiatic matters.

The giving of notice of the principal business of the initial meeting of the House of Representatives, outside of course, of the election of a new speaker.

The second of the notices was given by Mr. Marwick, of the Prime Minister.

1) Whether the Government will introduce legislation to prevent Indians from buying farms in Natal in juxtaposition with land held by European farmers, and, if so, when;

2) Whether it is the intention of the Government to proceed with the passing of the Class Areas Bill, which has reached the second reading stage during the last session of Parliament; or

3) Whether the Government intends to introduce any other Bill to provide for the segregation of the Asiatic population in the towns, separate residential and trading areas, and, if so, when; and

4) To what extent will the Government carry out the policy of compulsory re-entraining Asiatics at present in Natal who are originally from that Province as labourers or as traders from India, Arabia and elsewhere.

The questions were put by Mr. Marwick in the course, and effect, of the following reply from the Minister of the Interior, Dr. D. F. Malan—That it was the intention of the Government to proceed with the Class Areas Bill, that the question of legislation to prevent Indians from buying farms in Natal in juxtaposition with land held by European farmers, together with other questions of Indian segregation and compulsory re-entraining would receive the Government's consideration after the present Asiatic Land.

Under the South African Act it is permissible for a Provincial Council to recommend legislation to the Union Parliament. The Natal Council, in pursuance of this provision, recently passed certain recommendations on the question of the acquisition of land and licenses by Asiatics. These recommendations were read in both Houses of Parliament on Monday last. They are—
