



**POULTRY NOTES.**

**SHARING CHICKS.**

Sharing of chicks by hand is  
simple, less requires pasture and  
less work.

The principal rule is to feed  
little and often. Do not put down  
chicks in the sun for the tender  
chicks require feeding every hour  
to start with, and only sufficient  
food should be given so that the  
chicks should be kept warm.

As to the feeding of young chicks,  
opinions are very varied. From  
the fact is nourishing and  
house-keeping are the best, the  
farmer can get his best dis-  
cretion.

**HARD BOILED EGG.**

Personally, I always eat hard  
boiled egg in the birds for the  
first few days. This is one of the many  
ways of feeding which has  
been much overdone. Some  
breeders contend that chickens  
should be fed as much as possible  
on insects, others that they  
will not supply chicks with hard  
boiled eggs. This is the line of  
argument, it is a simple rule that  
the more insects the more nutritious  
the chicks will be.

Chicks are well adapted for arti-  
ficial rearing and feeding hence  
the success which has attended  
this method of rearing chicks as in  
tentative poultry farming.

Birds on free range, or even on  
semi-free range, will obtain a car-  
bonaceous diet, which will  
lighten the cost of feeding  
but beyond that fact they are  
given a diet which is not  
entirely fed is given artificially.

This fact is very evident when one  
considers the fact that the "back  
yard" poultry keepers at home.
