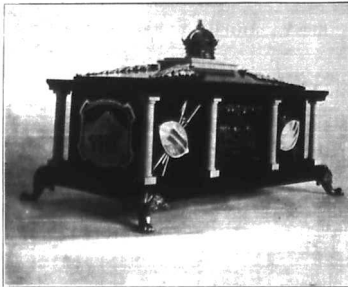

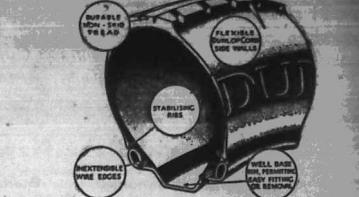

VERMOL KOL.

SUCCESSFULLY EXTERMINES MEALYBUG

Report by an Expert on E. Agriculture.

The experiments recently conducted with Vermol, though not extensive, have proved satisfactory. These were chiefly on the lines of soil function. The best results were obtained before or some time after rains, when the soil was not wet and had a temperature of from 65 to 85 degrees Fahrenheit. The surface soil was levelled round the base of the tree of an oz. of Vermol (fully grown coffee tree) was sprinkled round in a continuous band about two inches wide with the inner margin about 4 inches from the bark of the tree. Vermol was then covered with soil to the depth of 4 inches and packed well down. This killed the mealybug on the stem below ground in some cases kept of the ants completely.

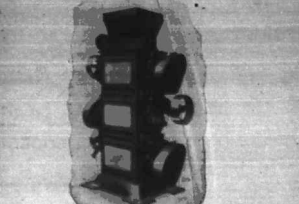

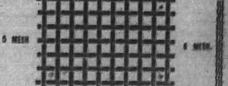
