PROCEEDINGS OF A BOARD CONVENED AT MOMBASA ON THE 9th JULY 1909 TO SURVEY THE STEAM LAUNCH "MVITA".

The Board having met proceeded to Direction Point, where the steam launch was lying high and dry at lew water, and examined her internally and externally and found her to be in the following condition:-

HULL.

The Hull very much strained, and consequently must work considerably, when the launch is under way.

STEM

Broken and patched.

FRAMES

All more or less decayed.

STERN POST Broken and patched.

KEEL.

Perished.

PLANKING

Quite soft and in many places perished.

BULKEEADS Both sprung badly.

COANTRGS Completely eaten away.

DECK

Perished.

The present condition of the Bull is due to her age (21 years) and the work upon which she has been engaged.

ENGINES.

With the exception of a small connection to the Air Pump, which requires repairing, the engines are in a fairly good condition.

BOILER.

With the exception of the Smoke-Rex and Funnel, which slight repairs, the Boiler is in good sessition. The Beard are unanisously of eminter, that the Launch

is unseaworthy, in her present condition. With the undermentioned repairs the Board consider that she can be made serviceable for one year only.

REPAIRS.

- 1. Two thwartship beams to be fixed underneath the deck and secured to Hull.
- 2. Strengthening Battens fastened to planking between each Frame amidships, undermeath the Boiler.
- 5. Two fore and aft beams placed underneath the Boileron each side of keelson and secured to the frames.

The Board recommend that provision be made in next year's Estimates for a larger and more serviceable Launch to replace the present one, which is quite unsuitable for the work she is now called upon to perform, viz: earrying the Mails round outside from Kilindini, and attending to the Broys and Beacons outside the harbours during the South West Monsoon, when a heavy sea runs at the entrance to the Harbours and therefore a considerable risk for a Launch of the size and build of the present one.

MEMORANDUM.

I have the honour to transmit herewith a record of the proceedings of a Board convened to survey the Steam Launch "Myita".

This Launch has now been in use here for 21 years and during that period has been constantly balled upon to undertake work, that was never intended for a Launch of her size and power, because no other launch was available.

The hull is now considerably strained and manking decayed, and the vital parts viz: stem and sternpost have had to be patched and the keel is quite rotten.

In view of the opinions of the Board that the Launch, when repaired will only be serviceable for another year, I would request you to submit this matter to His Excellency the Acting Governor and obtain his sanction for me to provide for a new launch, probable cost \$2,400, in the B timates for next year.
