Your Excellency:-

I referred Your Excellency's note of June 24th last, relative to the regulation of questions of common interest concerning the Juba River, to His Majesty's Secretary of State for the Colonies, and I have now the honour to inform Your Excellency that the proposal contained in that Note for the appointment of a commission of delegates of the Italian and British Governments to investigate the questions of the ownership of the islands in the river and the control of its waters is acceptable to His Majesty's Government.

I have the honour to suggest to Your Excellency that the arrangements for the appointment of the commission should be made locally between the administrations of Italian Somaliland and the East Africa Protectorate.
