Reply to the following effect:-

I am prepared to recommend to the Treasury that you should be permitted to incur additional expenditure up to half the amount of the increase in estimate of revenue. But this would more properly be done in connexion with revised estimates, when you have shown how you propose to effect necessary reallocations indicated in my despatch of 4<sup>th</sup> March No. 114. Also I should be glad to have details of proposed expenditure on veterinary quarantine. In the meantime large amount already sanctioned for this purpose will suffice to keep precautionary operations going.

My despatch of 10th December 1909 last

Report from Lesotho Province shows that for current year £47,333. Provincial Commissioner estimates hut tax for next financial year £50,000, instead of £41,700 as in draft estimates. Lay I therefore estimate accordingly by £8,300 at third reading and allocate half of the addition, that is £4,150 (to) veterinary quarantine on the self-help principle.
