My Lord,

The Director of Surveys, Major Smith, Esq., has brought to my notice that the work of Mr. J. D. Clark, District Surveyor, No. 1, is proved very unsatisfactory.

2. His output of work is far below the standard that a Surveyor of his class should maintain, and he has on several occasions shown a lack of technical judgment which has rendered many of his calculations useless.

3. Major Smith has asked that his appointment may be terminated under clause 10 of his agreement, and after careful consideration I am of opinion that his retention in the service is undesirable and have acceded to Major Smith's request.
